PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board (hereinafter EMSRB) has received a completed application from **Mille Lacs Health System Ambulance Service, Onamia, Minnesota**, for a new license, Part-Time Advanced Ambulance.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 144E.11, subdivision 3, each municipality, county, community health board, governing body of a regional emergency medical services system, ambulance service and other person wishing to make recommendations concerning the disposition of the application, shall make written recommendations or comments opposing the application to the EMSRB **within 30 days or by April 13, 2012, 4:30 p.m.**

Written recommendations or comments opposing the application should be sent to: Pamela Biladeau, Executive Director, EMSRB, 2829 University Avenue S.E., Suite 310, Minneapolis, Minnesota 55414-3222. If no more than five comments opposing the application are received during the comment period, and the EMSRB approves the application, the applicant will be exempt from a contested case hearing, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 144E.11, subdivision 4(a). If more than five comments in opposition to the application are received during the comment period, or the EMSRB denies the application, the applicant may immediately request a contested case hearing, or may try to resolve the objections of the public and/or the EMSRB within 30 days, pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 144E.11, subdivision 5(a), (b). If the applicant is unable to resolve the objections within 30 days, or if the applicant initially requests a contested case hearing, one will be scheduled and notice of the hearing given pursuant to Minnesota Statutes § 144E.11, subdivision 5(c)-(e).

Re: Proposed U.S. Steel Wetland Mitigation Site

Dear Chairman Wedel,

Thank you for your letter dated 2-29-12 concerning the above wetland mitigation project proposed by U.S. Steel Corporation. We appreciate Aitkin County's attention to this matter and understand the complexities that can be involved with such a large wetland mitigation project. The project is proposed to provide wetland mitigation required by a permit to mine under the regulatory jurisdiction of the MN Department of Natural Resources (DNR). This project is also currently being reviewed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) for federal Clean Water Act purposes. BWSR has reviewed the project and submitted comments to both the DNR and the Corps.

Your letter is correct that, while the DNR is responsible for approving the site for wetland mitigation under a permit to mine, the Aitkin County Drainage Authority is responsible for making the decision on a petition submitted for partial abandonment of public drainage system segments in accordance with MN Stat. Chapter 103E. The relationship between state and federal wetland laws and MN drainage law can be complicated. We agree that it is important for all involved to understand the delineation of these authorities.

In regard to the submitted petition for partial abandonment, the County, as the drainage authority, can require the petitioner to provide hydrologic and hydraulic analyses (including presentation to the drainage authority) demonstrating why the proposed wetland restoration project will not adversely affect benefited properties on the drainage system outside the project area. BWSR commonly performs such analyses for wetland restoration projects undertaken by the State, and submits this information to the drainage authority as part of the engineering design report for the project. This is a reasonable requirement of any project proponent because it is a key basis for drainage authority decisions on partial abandonment petitions per MN Stat. § 103E.806, Subd. 3(b). Potential concern by the drainage authority over the objectivity of such analyses may require separate review by the drainage authority's engineering advisor, but this should be significantly less work than actually conducting, reporting, and presenting the analyses.

Your letter also referenced the Natural Resources Block Grant (NRBG) and the need for additional funding. While the NRBG does not fund drainage authorities for implementation of public drainage law, it does provide funding that supports local government implementation of the Wetland Conservation Act (WCA). We generally agree that State funding for WCA implementation is insufficient. WCA local government units face challenges, issues, and types of projects that differ due to varying circumstances across the state. We work to distribute grant funds among local governments that reflect these varied circumstances. BWSR is planning on reviewing current grant allocation formulas, but please recognize that a redistribution of existing NRBG funds would benefit some local governments while decreasing the abilities of others to implement basic WCA responsibilities.


We agree that the issues you have identified require a long-term resolution, including the identification of solutions that will result in high quality wetland mitigation projects in locations that will provide the greatest public benefit without negatively impacting local economies. In fact, BWSR has initiated the formation of an interagency work-group to address this issue.

Recent statute changes (MN Stat. 103G.222, Subd. 3) provide opportunities to address replacement wetland siting under WCA to a certain extent. However, laws and rules relating to the federal Clean Water Act, mining, and State water quality standards are all applicable to the siting of replacement wetlands *in addition* to WCA. As such, the long-term resolution must address each of these requirements in order to positively affect the end result.

The interagency work-group includes representatives from BWSR, DNR, Corps, and the MN Pollution Control Agency. While replacement wetland siting is an issue that includes several variables and considerations, the ultimate goal of the work-group is to identify solutions to the very issues you have identified in your letter. BWSR is also committed to continuing our dialogue with DNR to ensure current WCA requirements are implemented consistently for all projects, including mining.

Thank you again for your letter and concerns over this matter. We share your desire to improve the process by which wetland replacement projects are identified, approved, and implemented, and remain committed to working towards solutions that will provide outcomes acceptable to all.

Early Spring special event - Soo Line Trails to open March 23rd

Due to the early spring conditions the North and South Soo Line ATV trails will open for on-trail ATV riding on 3/23/12. Normally the trail opens April 1st but due to the unusually warm weather the snow is gone and conditions on the trail are suitable for ATV use. The early opening is due to efforts of the McGregor Area Chamber of Commerce and Aitkin County to try to give local businesses along the trail a tourism boost by adding an extra two weekends to the ATV season after a very poor snowmobile season. The MACC was issued a special event permit from March 23rd to April 1st by the County Land Department. This event applies to the Soo Line trails ONLY - no off-trail travel on side trails is allowed. "My hope is that tourism dependent businesses can benefit from this event and that ATV riders can enhance their image in the community by helping businesses and obeying the rules (STAY ON THE TRAIL)." stated Mark Jacobs - Aitkin County Land Commissioner.

Awards

Locomotive Award – This one goes to the people who actually run the railroad. Although most of the wood shipped in Minnesota is transported by truck, there are some rail sidings that are used to ship wood. These provide valuable alternatives to local markets. Although there have been logistical problems regarding the availability of rail cars, the ACLT has been impressed with the response and efforts by the CN and particularly Mr. Kevin Soucie, VP Government Affairs DC, in meeting the needs and concerns of loggers using these rail shipping sites.

Conductor Award – The conductor oversees the operation of the train and ensures that it is traveling properly. Governor Mark Dayton and his Administration have, in the last year, proven to be extremely responsive, supportive and constructive in working with the timber industry to hear our concerns and to work to resolve issues. This past November, Labor and Industry Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner attended the ACLT Board of Directors meeting. Numerous interactions with the Commissioner and Assistant Commissioner of the MNDNR have resulted in positive outcomes. As a conductor, if this is how Governor Dayton plans to operate the train of state government the ACLT is confident that the trip will be positive and smooth.

Caboose Award – This award goes to the Aitkin County Public Works and Commissioners. Recently Aitkin County posted bridge restrictions that prevented the transportation of timber to mills via the most direct and cost effective route. When these types of situations have occurred in the past with St. Louis County and MNDOT reasonable compromises were reached to support the transportation needs of the timber industry and protect the infrastructure. However, Aitkin County felt that the bridge in question that had been carrying the standard weight just eight months prior to the posting would not be able to carry the same weight during the winter harvest season.
