The City of Tamarack has requested a parcel of County tax forfeited land (PID = 61-1-013200) with a structure within the city limits. We've offered this parcel for sale in several times in the past few years with no success. The house is partially finished and is a bit of an eyesore. The Land Department staff maintains this property mow/trim, etc; and the cost is adding up. MN statute 282.01 allows a governmental subdivision to purchase TF property for below market price if they have a plan for rehabilitation of the blighted property. The City has offered \$100 for the property and has plans to rehabilitate the building for a City hall/offices. They will need to submit their plans in writing.

I recommend allowing this purchase contingent on the city submitting their written rehabilitation plan for the property.
