

Aitkin County Roads affected by Flooding

6:30 am Tuesday, June 26, 2012

Due to recent heavy rainfall, the following County Roads in Aitkin County are closed due to wash-outs or high water until further notice.

Closures due to washed-out roadbeds/culverts

1. County Road 3 (old State Highway 232) near the State Highway 65 intersection, located north of McGregor – opened as of 11:00 am 6-22-12
2. County Road 6 approximately 3 miles east of State Highway 65 located north of McGregor – opened as of 5:00 pm 6-21-12
3. County Road 6 approximately 1 mile east of State Highway 65 located north of McGregor
4. County Road 12 approximately 1 mile south of the State Highway 47 intersection, located south of Aitkin – opened as of 10:30 am 6-21-12
5. County Road 12 approximately 2 miles west of the State Highway 47 intersection in Glen –opened as of 11:00 am 6-23-12

Attached is the updated list of flood impacted roads.

The washout on County Road 30 was repaired yesterday, so that closure and the additional closure due to deep water over the road further east on County Road 30 have both been removed as of yesterday.

Also note from the list that County Road 5 north of Palisade has once again been closed, although in a different area than had previously been closed.

The County Road 12 washout 1 mile south of State Highway 47 near Aitkin is once again undermining. We are pursuing a permanent fix at this location later in the week which would cause the road to be closed during the 6-8 hour repair.

The Rice River at State Highway 169 crested yesterday morning and the water is receding slowly. Although I haven't heard anything from MnDOT, it appears US Highway 169 through this area will remain open.

Attached is our updated listed of flood impacted roads. The status of closed roads due to washouts or high water is unchanged with the exception that County Road 3 (old State Highway 232) has been closed from State Highway 65 to County Road 63 due to high water. The listing of segments with water on the road is also changing as the water drops on certain segment and rises on others. We anticipate being able to repair the washed out portion of County Road 30 today. The washout on County Road 6 is not repairable at this time, so this closure will likely remain through the week. An assessment of the County Road 36 closure will be done later today to determine it's repair status.

State Highway 65 has been restricted to a single lane of traffic 1 mile north of State Highway 210. The water is dropping in this area and will be opened to both lanes of traffic by MnDOT when the water is completely off the road.

Attached is our updated listing of flood impacted roads. As anticipated, the County Road 12 closure was repaired and re-opened yesterday. County Road 62 was closed yesterday due to high water on the road from County Road 71 to 1 mile west. As water continues to rise on Big Sandy, additional closures are anticipated on County Road 3 (old State Highway 232).

Both lanes of traffic on State Highway 210 between McGregor and Tamarack are now open. State Highway 65 1 mile north of McGregor was closed temporarily yesterday, but then re-opened later in the day. There is still up to 4 inches of water on the road, so the public needs to exercise extreme caution when traveling through this area.

The water at the US Highway 169 Rice River bridge crossing continues to rise and MnDOT is continuing to monitor it.

After this morning's assessment, we have no changes to our listing of flood impacted road segments. I have attached the same listing that was sent late yesterday, which is also posted on the County website.

County crews will be working today to repair the County Road 12 washout west of Glen. Unless the situation changes, we do not anticipate working tomorrow as we will be caught up repairing everything that is repairable at this time. We will still have road closures due to washouts on County Road 6, County Road 30, and County Road 36, but there is too much water still flowing through those areas to proceed with repairs at this time. In addition, we will still have the seven listed road closures due to high water. All we can do in those areas is wait for the water to drop.

The State Highway 210 road closure between McGregor and Tamarack is being opened this morning by MnDOT. Initially, it will still be restricted to one lane for about ¼ mile with a signal system that is being installed right now. As water continues to drop off the eastbound lane in this area, both lanes will be opened, likely sometime today or tomorrow barring further significant rainfall.

MnDOT is closing State Highway 65 from State Highway 210 in McGregor to the Libby Dam area due to water on the road at the Sandy River crossing and anticipated water on the road at the Libby Dam outlet. A traffic detour will be set utilizing State Highways 200, 169, and 210. As I understand it, local traffic will be allowed on TH 65, which should make

for an interesting situation since most of the traffic on State Highway 65 is essentially local traffic accessing the Big Sandy/Minnewawa area.

MnDOT is continuing to monitor the Rice River bridge on US Hwy 169 north of Aitkin. The critical water elevation for this bridge is 10 inches higher than it currently is. The water has only risen 2 inches at this location in the last 36 hours, so it's possible that the critical elevation for the bridge won't be reached. However, the bridge could still sustain damage that would require action even if the water doesn't rise, which is why it is being closely monitored.

I will provide further updates throughout the weekend if needed. If you hear nothing further from me regarding our listing of impacted roads, please assume that the information provided with this update is still accurate.

Attached is our most current listing of flood impacted roads as of 6:30 pm on Friday, June 22.

Although we had re-opened County Road 6 to traffic late yesterday, another washout occurred 1 mile east of State Highway 65 this afternoon, so County Road 6 is once again closed to traffic. Washouts on County Road 3 (Old State Highway 232) and County Road 13 were repairs and those segments re-opened today.

State Highway 65 south of McGregor reopened to traffic this afternoon around 4:30 pm. MnDOT made it a priority to get that segment opened and they did an excellent job of achieving it. As of now, water on State Highway 210 between McGregor and Tamarack has dropped to an inch or so. MnDOT is hopeful that they may be able to re-open this area sometime over the weekend. Although water is dropping in that area approximately 5 miles east of McGregor, water is rising on both State Highway 210 within a mile of McGregor and on State Highway 65 1 mile north of 210. Potential additional road closures may result in these areas in the coming days.

The bridge on US Hwy 169 over the Rice River was inspected early this afternoon by MnDOT. If the water rises another 12 inches at the bridge, they believe at this time that they will either need to detour traffic or take further precautions to protect the bridge, which may result in traffic restrictions. They are performing calculations to further refine their options.

We will have crews working tomorrow to continue repairs.

Attached is our most current listing of flood-impacted roads.

Note that County Road 6 has been reopened to traffic as of 5:00 pm yesterday. Crews will be working to re-open washed out areas on County Road 3 and County Road 13 today.

The report from MnDOT is that water is not yet dropping on the closed areas of State Highway 210 between McGregor and Tamarack and State Highway 65 south of McGregor. It appears nearly certain that these road closures will remain in effect into next week. State Highway 65 north of McGregor is becoming a concern as water continues to rise at the Sandy River crossing. State Highway 200 between Hill City and Jacobson was closed to traffic yesterday due to a washed out culvert.

Contrary to the information I provided yesterday, the water has receded on US Hwy 169 at County Road 3, so Hwy 169 did not go under water in this area as anticipated. However, the water at the Rice River and Sissabagamah crossings south of Hassman corner on US Hwy 169 continues to rise. MnDOT will be inspecting those bridges today with anticipated bridge and road closures in the near future if the water continues to rise.

As requested at this morning's meeting, following is the flooding update that was sent earlier today. Also attached is our current listing of impacted areas.

The County Road 12 road closure 1 mile south of State Highway 47 is open as of 11:00 am today. Please note that there is one remaining closure on County Road 12 located 2 miles west of State Highway 47 in Glen.

Crews are currently working to repair the County Road 6 washout. I will let you know when it is re-opened hopefully later today.

US Hwy 169 at County Road 3 is starting to go under water. By evening, the entire road may be covered and is anticipated that the depth of water on the road will continue to increase as the Mississippi River stage increases. I am in contact with MNDOT-Baxter and will keep you informed as changes are made. I anticipate they will continue to route

US Hwy 169 through this area until the water gets too deep and/or fast moving. That could happen as early as tomorrow based on the NWS projections.

Speaking of the NWS, they did not lower the projected peak stage for Aitkin and continue to emphasize that we need to be prepared for a 20.5 peak stage.

Subject: Flood Update

As of now, we have 11 locations on County Roads where the road/culvert has been washed out and the road is therefore closed. These closures are on portions of CSAH 3, 6, 13, 30, 36, and CR 64 in the McGregor area, CSAH 5 in the Palisade area, CSAH 34 in the Arthyde area, and portions of CSAH 12, and 54 in the Aitkin area. In addition, we have numerous other roads that are still underwater. The website link contains more information on the specific areas that are affected. In addition, the website link to the statewide road closure map gives a graphical picture of the closures. MnDOT's closures on this map are not up-to-date, however.

We are anticipating that we will be able to get most of the 11 closures re-opened by this Friday or Saturday. Our focus will be getting them opened to traffic, with more extensive work being done within the coming weeks. At this time we anticipate all of the closures on the major roads to be opened by Saturday. These include closures on CSAH 3, 6, 12 and 13.

We currently have residents on CSAH 30 and CR 64 in the Tamarack area that have no access to their residence because the road in both directions is closed. CR 64 is the worst because of the Tamarack River crossings. In addition, I'm sure there are many residents on township roads that will have no access until the water drops.

The Mississippi River stage at Aitkin is currently 16.5, which is below the projection of 18.0 based on yesterday's prediction. The predicted crest is still 20.5 and if that happens we will have additional road closures in the Aitkin area. I will be talking to NWS and Army Corps today to try to get a better read on whether or not we will achieve that crest.

TH 210 is currently closed between McGregor and Tamarack with traffic being detoured onto CSAH 6, 40, and 14. TH 65 is currently closed between McGregor and County Road 4 with traffic being detoured onto CSAH 4. Although MnDOT has not given a timeframe for these closures to re-open, I anticipate TH 65 being closed beyond a week as there is extensive pavement repair that will be needed when the water drops. TH 210 doesn't appear to have sustained as much damage, so it will hopefully be opened sooner, although that may not be before next week also. With I35 and TH 73 both closed, much of the north-south traffic through the northeast region of the state is being routed on US Hwy 169 thru Aitkin. If the Mississippi River gets as high as projected, US Hwy 169 will also close at some point at the Rice River crossing with traffic needing to be detoured even further west.

I am working to obtain damage cost estimates and will provide that information when it is available.

WHEREAS, the state Parks and Trails Legacy plan calls for a statewide system of parks and trails, and

WHEREAS, Greater MN Regional Parks and Trails have been underfunded for decades when compared to investments in the metro park system over that same time period, and

WHEREAS, the public expressed overwhelming support at 17 state-sponsored public meetings for the highest quality statewide regional projects possible as a preferred outcome of the 25 year plan, and

WHEREAS, the first round of park and trail legacy funding in 2009 was unfair to Greater Minnesota - with 43% of the funding dedicated to metro park needs, 43% dedicated to DNR park and trail needs and projects, while leaving only 14% funding for a statewide grants program which included Metro Parks. Of that 14%, 20% of those funds were given to the Metro Park Area , and

WHEREAS, the second round of park and trail legacy funding in 2011, produced better but still lopsided results with Greater Minnesota receiving 20% in dedicated legacy funding, while metro parks received 42% and DNR received 38%, and

WHEREAS, a 2011 inventory of Greater Minnesota park and trail needs resulted in \$76 million in projects, and over \$33 million in grant request - or more than four times the amount of the 2011 legacy grants awarded to Greater Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, Greater Minnesota pre-legacy park and trail funding was spotty and scarce, and

WHEREAS, the Legacy Act has resulted in Greater Minnesota being charged by both the public and the state plan to build the highest quality statewide regional projects possible.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Aitkin County believes Greater Minnesota should receive adequate funding to carry out the state plan and the public sentiment for high quality projects, and

Aitkin County believes the current Park and Trail Legacy splits of 43% metro, 37% DNR and 20% to Greater Minnesota are inherently unfair to Greater Minnesota and not enough to carry out the state plan or meet public expectations, and

Aitkin County believes the legacy funding splits at 43% metro, 37% DNR and 20% for the remaining 80 non-metro counties is not fair and will not provide the funding to allow Greater Minnesota to succeed in carrying out expectations of either the public or the state plan, and

Aitkin County believes the Greater Minnesota percentage of Legacy funding should increase to a level more equal to those of the metro area and DNR.

Commissioner Napstad moved the adoption of the resolution and it was declared adopted upon the following vote

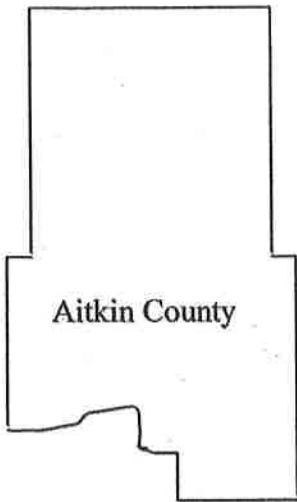

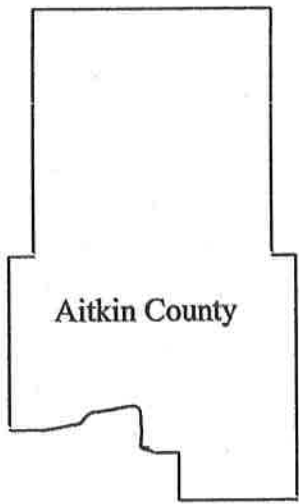

Our speaker will be Gary Drotts from the Wildlife Management Area to explain the area and what is in the works.

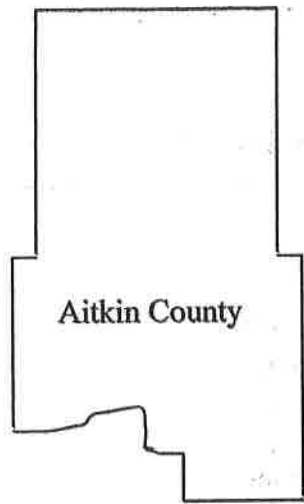
