Aitkin County, Minnesota

VHF INTEROPERABLE FREQUENCY USE AGREEMENT

Whereas, the Aitkin County Board of Commissioners, as the governing body of Aitkin County desires to enter into an agreement with the State of Minnesota, Department of Public Safety (DPS) for use of certain state licensed radio frequencies for the purpose of coordination between emergency response agencies and resources.

Whereas, Aitkin County is a member of the Northeast Regional Radio Board (RRB).

Whereas, participation in the Minnesota VHF Interoperable Communications Plan must be approved by the County and submitted to the RRB for approval before radio equipment intended for use by public safety officials within the County can be programmed and used under the state license.

Now Therefore, the Aitkin County Board of Commissioners, as the governing body of Aitkin County, approves the Minnesota VHF Interoperable Communications Plan agreement applicable to the use of state licensed radio frequencies by County public safety officials:

I. Background

To the extent permitted by federal laws and regulations, the Statewide Radio Board (SRB), operating as the State Interoperability Executive Committee (SIEC), is responsible for developing guidelines and standards for the use of interoperability frequencies on all frequency spectrums assigned to public safety users in Minnesota. Given the widespread use of VHF frequencies in the state by agencies not utilizing ARMER, the Minnesota DPS has developed a VHF Interoperable Communications Plan to provide guidance for the use of VHF interoperable frequencies by public safety agencies operating in Minnesota during local, regional, and statewide emergency responses. The plan was subsequently approved by the SRB on 10/27, 2011.

Under this plan, DPS will also license all of the narrowband channels listed in Appendix A - Statewide VHF Interoperability Channels for statewide operations with mobiles and fixed temporary bases or fixed mobile relays (repeaters) as appropriate by January 1, 2013. This allows authorized agencies operating under this agreement with DPS to operate mobile radios and temporary bases or repeaters on the statewide VHF interoperability channels without having to file for and maintain separate licenses for these channels. This also provides the state the ability to deploy temporary bases and repeaters on the statewide interoperability channels as needed to support disaster and emergency responses.

DPS will also establish separate licenses for the narrowband channels listed in Section IV for permanent fixed base operations as needed to integrate these channels into the ARMER VHF interoperability infrastructure. This phase of the plan will be completed in July 2012 in order to provide sufficient time for the transition of these channels to narrowband operations by January 2013 as mandated by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). Continued operation of fixed bases on these channels by local and regional public safety agencies after January 1, 2013 must be coordinated and documented with DPS and Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) in order to eliminate duplicated coverage, interference, and channel contention.

II. Determination of Need

There is a need to provide standardized interoperability channels in the VHF band between VHF public safety radio users that may respond to incidents within the state and between these VHF radio users and ARMER radio system users.

III. Terms of Agreement

The Minnesota DPS shall apply for, manage, and maintain proper licenses for the use of statewide VHF interoperability channels. DPS shall also manage and maintain an accurate database of federal, state, and local agencies that have agreed to participate in the standardized use of these channels. DPS will issue updates and revisions to the Minnesota VHF Interoperable Communications plan contained herein as directed by request by the Statewide Radio Board.

The County shall participate in regional communications planning and manage use of the statewide VHF interoperability channels by public safety agencies within the county, ensuring compliance with the Minnesota VHF Interoperable Communications Plan as well as applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances and regulations.

Minnesota DPS and the County mutually agree to the following conditions for use of the statewide VHF interoperability channels:

- a. Use the statewide VHF interoperability channels for day-to-day coordination, for urgent or emergency mutual aid situations, for task forces, for tactical teams, and for other purposes. Such coordination may occur during interagency operations, en-route travel, or on-incident;
- b. Use of the statewide VHF interoperability channels must be in compliance with the rules governing the VHF frequencies, and be authorized by the Incident Command (IC) or Unified Command (UC) structure at the scene of the incident or planned event;

- c. Radio communications procedures on the statewide VHF interoperability channels must be consistent with the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and Incident Command System (ICS) including the use of "plain language" without 10-codes or agency-specific codes/jargon; and
- d. When operating on the statewide VHF interoperability channels, users should initially identify in the following manner using plain English: Agency name, followed by service branch or function designation, followed by call sign or unit number. Examples:"North EMS 512", "Elk River Police 512", "Washington County Public Works 512", "State Patrol 512", etc. Once established, ongoing communications between the same units may be shortened.

IV. VHF Statewide Interoperability Zone

To facilitate uniform field access to the statewide VHF interoperability channels, all VHF subscriber radios authorized under this agreement should be programmed to include the following standardized VHF Statewide Interoperability Zone or "SI Zone".

Appendix A - Statewide VHF Interoperability Zone Cheat Sheet

The standard mode of operation for the VCALL and VTAC channels is analog narrowband. All fixed, mobile, and portable radios should transmit using the 156.7 Hz CTCSS code. All mobile and portable radios should be set for carrier squelch unless CTCSS is necessary in order to mitigate interference.

The standard mode of operation for the IR2 channels is analog narrowband. All fixed, mobile, and portable radios should transmit using the 167.9 Hz CTCSS code. All mobile and portable radios should be set for carrier squelch unless CTCSS is necessary in order to mitigate interference.

The standard mode of operation for the LE2 channel is P25 digital narrowband, and all mobile and portable radios on this LE channel should use the \$68F digital network access code.

Set Date for Tax-Forfeited Land Sale

WHEREAS, the classification of the following county owned and tax-forfeited lands to be offered for sale has been made by the County Board in accordance with Minnesota Statues 282, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on March 6, 2012 at 10:00 am in the Aitkin County Courthouse regarding the classification to the attached lands and classified them to dispose of, and

WHEREAS, the County Board has made appraisals of the lands classified as non-conservation and of the timber and timber products thereon, and has made appraisal of timber and buildings on such lands as have not been classified, and a list of such lands and timber, timber only and of buildings so appraised has been filed with the County Auditor for the purpose of offering lands, timber and buildings, so listed, for sale at not less than the appraised value of the land, timber, and buildings combined, with said appraisals of each property following, and

WHEREAS, the list of lands classified as non-conservation land in the Conservation Areas and a list of the lands classified as non-conservation in the tax forfeited areas, has been submitted to the Commissioner of Natural Resources for his approval of the classification and sale of such, and

WHEREAS, the County Board is by law designated with authority to provide for the sale of such lands on terms:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that such parcels shall be sold on the following terms, to wit: That on sales amounting to \$5,000.00 or less per parcel, the purchase price shall be paid in full at the time of purchase. On sales amounting to more than \$5,000.00 per parcel, the purchaser shall pay a minimum of \$5,000.00 down or 25% of the purchase price (whichever is greater) with the privilege of paying the balance over 5 years with the balance amortized over the 5 years plus interest at the rate according to Minnesota Statutes 282.01, Subdivision 4, on the deferred balance. Any remaining balance may be paid at any time. If the property is purchased on a contract for deed, a \$46.00 fee will be required at the time of purchase for the recording of the contract. Any contract for deeds on properties on this sale, are required to be recorded. Any property with a known well on it, will be charged a \$50.00 fee for recording the well certificate. Any property purchased on a contract for deed that has buildings on it, will be required to carry insurance on the property with Aitkin County as a loss payable on it until such time as the building and timber costs have been paid in full. The insurance binder will be required to be sent to the Land Department within 5 days of the purchase.

Provided that in case any parcel of land bearing standing timber, buildings or timber products is sold at public auction for more than the appraised value, the amount bid in excess of the appraised value shall be allocated between the land, buildings, and timber in proportion to the respective appraised value. The purchaser of tax-forfeited land at such sale shall be entitled to immediate possession, subject to the provision of any existing lease made in behalf of the State, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of such sale of lands, timber and buildings be given by publication in the official newspaper of the County as provided by law; that the County Auditor of Aitkin County offer such parcels of land for sale in the order in which they appear in said NOTICE OF SALE, and that such sale shall commence at <u>10:00</u> A.M. on Thursday, the <u>30th</u> day of <u>August</u>, <u>2012</u> and continue until all parcels classified as non-conservation and timber only, buildings on parcels not classified, are offered to the highest bidder for sale. This sale will be held at the 40 Club Convention Center in Aitkin.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, as required by Minnesota Statutes 284.28, there will be added to the sale price of any tax-forfeited lands sold, an amount equal to three percent of the total sale price. Said additional amount to be deposited in the State Treasury and credited to the State Real Estate Assurance Fund, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Land Commissioner may withdraw any description on the list, later subject to the approval of the County Board, when it may appear to be in the public interest to do so, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Minnesota Statutes 282.014, imposes a \$25.00 fee upon purchasers of taxforfeited land for issuance of a State Deed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, as required by Minnesota Statutes 282.01, Subdivision 6, all State Tax Deeds must be recorded with the County Recorder prior to issuing the Deed to the purchaser, therefore a recording fee for each State Deed issued must be paid to the Aitkin County Recorder by the purchaser when tax-forfeited land is paid for in full, as required in MS 357.18.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, as required by Minnesota Statutes 287.22, all State Tax Deeds are subject to State Deed Tax which must be paid by the purchaser.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Aitkin County is not responsible for location of or determining property lines or boundaries.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all lands sold hereunder are sold subject to the Zoning Ordinance adopted by the County Board, and all lands are sold subject to railroad and highway easements, power and pipeline easements, any recreational easements, and subject to all flowage rights.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that except in the case of Deeds issued for platted property and Deeds issued to correct errors in either legal description or grantees, the Deeds issued for these parcels will contain a restrictive covenant which will prohibit enrollment of the land in a State Funded program providing compensation of marginal land or wetlands.

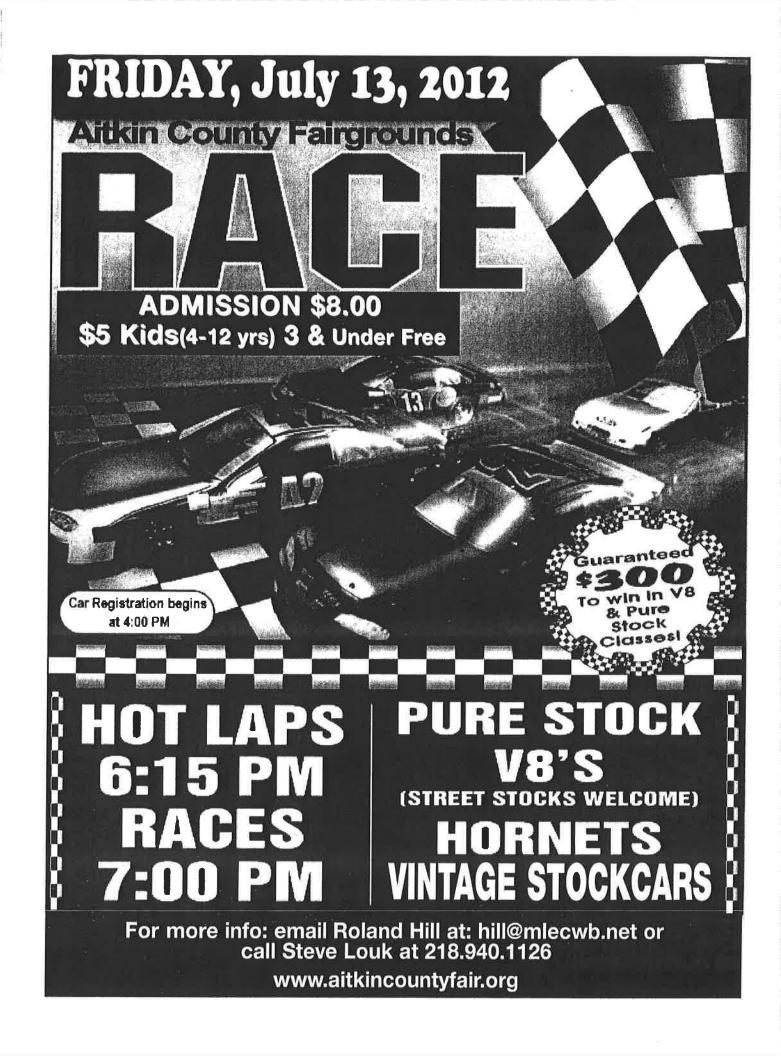

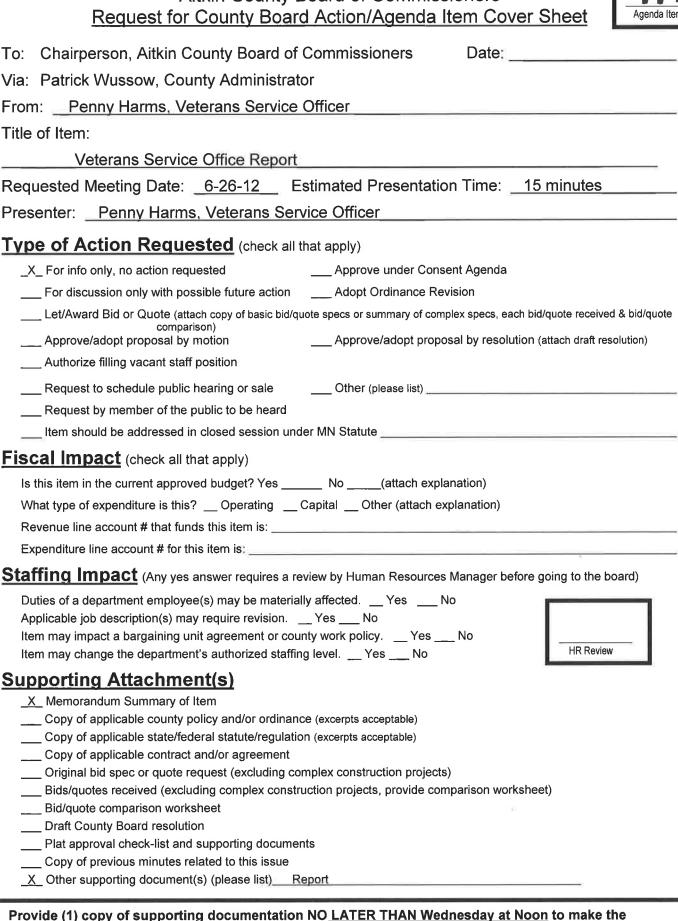

Veterans Service Office Report

June 19, 2012

The number of Veterans living in Aitkin County in FY 2011 is approximately 2,290

- I. Veterans Services Office data January 1, 2011 Dec 31, 2011
 - a. 800 office visits
 - b. 14 outreach visits in McGregor, 7 visits to veterans homes or nursing home
 - c. 120 new clients
 - d. 57 new veterans signed up for VA medical benefits
 - e. 925 forms completed and mailed to the VA
 - f. 3900 files edited in VIMS (Veterans Information Management System)
- II. 2011 Vet Van Statistics
 - a. 169 trips to Mpls and St. Cloud
 - b. 262 veterans rode the Aitkin County Veterans van.
 - c. Total Expenses \$16,782
 - d. Reimbursements \$12,562
 - e. Net expenses for vet van \$4,219.
- III. Federal Benefits to Aitkin County Veterans FY 2011
 - a. Compensation and Pension \$ 5,680,000
 - b. Education and Vocational Rehabilitation \$ 117,000

Total Federal VA \$s coming directly to veterans in Aitkin County = \$ 5,852,000. That is up almost 1 million dollars from last year and all of that is for compensation and pension (FY10 total = \$4,904,000)

- IV. MN Department of Veterans Affairs State Soldier's Assistance Program to Aitkin County Veterans –

Efforts to assist veterans in obtaining employement.

According to an article in the StarTribune in February 2012. Minnesota's unemployment rate for veterans who have served after the September 11 attacks is almost 23 percent. This is more than 3 times the state's overall unemployment rate.

Many new programs are being developed and implemented to assist veterans in obtaining employment.

VRAP – Veterans Retraining and Assistance Program offers up to 12 months of training in a high demand skill to unemployed veterans who are not eligible for other VA education programs. This program is available for veterans between 35 and 60 who are currently unemployed.

Career and job fairs are offered at Central Lakes College in Brainerd for Veterans. They are also offering National Career Readiness Certificate Testing for recent veterans.

Effective April 19, 2012, MN Veterans Preference points increased to 10 points for veterans and 15 points for veterans with service connected disability applying for local government positions.

Effective August 1, 2012, state agencies can choose to appoint a disabled veteran with 30% or more service connected disability to a classified position without interviewing other candidates as long as the veteran is qualified for the position.

Tax credits are offered to private employers for hiring vets.

Veteran owned businesses are also given preference in awarding government contracts.

Beyond the Yellow Ribbon

Aitkin County Beyond the Yellow Ribbon Chapter is working to provide assistance to veterans and their families. We have numerous volunteers willing to provide services such as lawn mowing, mentoring and even minor home repair.

Our biggest obstacle is that we do not know who the recent returning veterans are or even how many. But we have a network of volunteers willing and ready to help in whatever way we can. Our group has also decided to extend our assistance any veteran or military family regardless of when and where they were in the military.

Disaster Relief Grants

The MN Department of Veterans Affairs Disaster Relief Grants are for veterans affected by flooding and or storms since Jun 13, 2012. Veterans and their families can apply for up to \$750 in reimbursement if they have not received other state or federal assistance.

Disaster Relief Grants Available for Minnesota Veterans and Families

As a result of recent flooding and storms, the Minnesota Department of Veterans Affairs is offering Disaster Relief Grants for reimbursable expenses to Veterans in Aitkin, Carlton, Cook, Dakota, Goodhue, Lake, Rice and St Louis County, per the Governor's Emergency Executive Order 12-09.

Veterans, their families and surviving spouses may be eligible for reimbursement assistance funds of up to \$750 if they have not received other state or federal assistance.

Veterans and their families in Aitkin County should contact Penny Harms, Aitkin County Veterans Service Officer at 218-927-7320, 888-404-7320, or <u>penny.harms@co.aitkin.mn.us</u> to apply for a Disaster Relief Grant. Benefits must be applied for no later than September 30th, 2012
