### Flood Update

President Obama signed a Presidential Disaster Declaration on July 6<sup>th</sup> for PUBLIC ASSISTANCE (Assistance for emergency work and the repair or replacement of disaster-damaged facilities). FEMA representatives will be in northern Minnesota on July 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> conducting a preliminary damage assessment to individual homes. A few roads remain covered with water and closed. Most township roads around Big Sandy Lake are open at this time. Restrictions are in place on 25 of Aitkin County's hundreds of lakes. The Mississippi River at Aitkin crested Thursday, June 28<sup>th</sup> at 18.71 feet. The gage reading at 6:00 a.m. today was at 16.11 feet. That is down over 31 inches. Severe flooding continues on Big Sandy Lake. The crest on June 28<sup>th</sup> was at 1222.93 feet. According to the most recent river gage reading, at 7:00 a.m. today, the level was at 1221.72 feet – down more than 14.5 inches. (However, it is up more than 2 inches since yesterday afternoon.) The record lake level was an elevation of 1224.82 May 19, 1950.

Aitkin County Emergency Management continues to make sand bags available to residents who wish to undertake sandbagging operations. The cities of Aitkin and McGregor, as well as Shamrock Township, continue to assist in this process. Aitkin County Public Health is providing information to help residents stay safe with clean up, water and other flood-related issues.

Emergency supplies (food, water and cleaning supplies) are available at the Aitkin County Sheriff's Office, Grace Lutheran Church (Big Sandy) and the Hill City Snowmobile Club building. A drop-in center has been set up at **Grace Lutheran Church** they will be open daily until July 13<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Sunday hours are 10:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Debris from flood victims may be brought to the McGregor Transfer Station (Hwy. 65 North of McGregor), J & H Transfer on C.R. #13 and Garrison Disposal in Aitkin free of charge. Acceptable materials include: plaster board (sheetrock), wallboard, wood, pipes, wiring, shingles, cement, insulation, lumber, window glass, carpet left in the building, any part of the building structure, lamps, furniture, mattresses, bedding, clothing, books, magazines, papers, cardboard, small appliances, cookware and dishes, carpet removed from the building, and any asbestos-containing waste.

Please report any unsafe situations immediately by calling **911**.

# Please Separate Your Wastes

Waste management recommendations after a natural disaster

## Residents

As you clean up after the flood, please protect yourself by wearing waterproof gloves and by washing up with soap afterwards.

To minimize the impact to the environment and to better control the cleanup costs, please **separate your waste into four piles as listed below.**

<b>1. Large Appliances</b>	Refrigerators, freezers, ovens, dishwashers, air conditioners, furnaces, washing machines, clothes dryers.
<b>2. Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)</b>  <b>Note:</b> Please put any leaking containers of HHW in a plastic bag or tub. Do not mix wastes. Keep labels with products or write the name on the container so wastes can be identified and safely handled.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Automotive products</b>, such as gas, oil, antifreeze, and parts cleaners</li><li>• <b>Household cleaners</b>, such as bleach, ammonia, oven cleaners, toilet cleaners and kitchen cleaners</li><li>• <b>Mercury-containing items</b>, such as thermometers, thermostats and fluorescent light bulbs</li><li>• <b>Paints and solvents</b>, such as oil or latex paints, stains, thinners, spray paints, acetone, xylene and toluene</li><li>• <b>Lawn products</b>, including fertilizers and pesticides (such as fungicides, insecticides and herbicides)</li><li>• <b>Other items</b> that you think should not go into the regular trash, such as gas cylinders, batteries, swimming pool chemicals</li></ul>
<b>3. Demolition and Solid Waste</b>	Plasterboard (such as Sheetrock), wallboard, wood, pipes, wiring, shingles, cement, insulation, lumber, window glass, carpet left in the building, any part of the building structure, lamps, furniture, mattresses, bedding, clothing, books, magazines, papers, cardboard, small appliances, cookware and dishes, carpet removed from the building, and any asbestos-containing waste
<b>4. Food Waste</b>	Household garbage, food,

Waste accepted at these transfer stations include: Demolition and Solid Waste, Household Hazardous Waste, and Appliances.

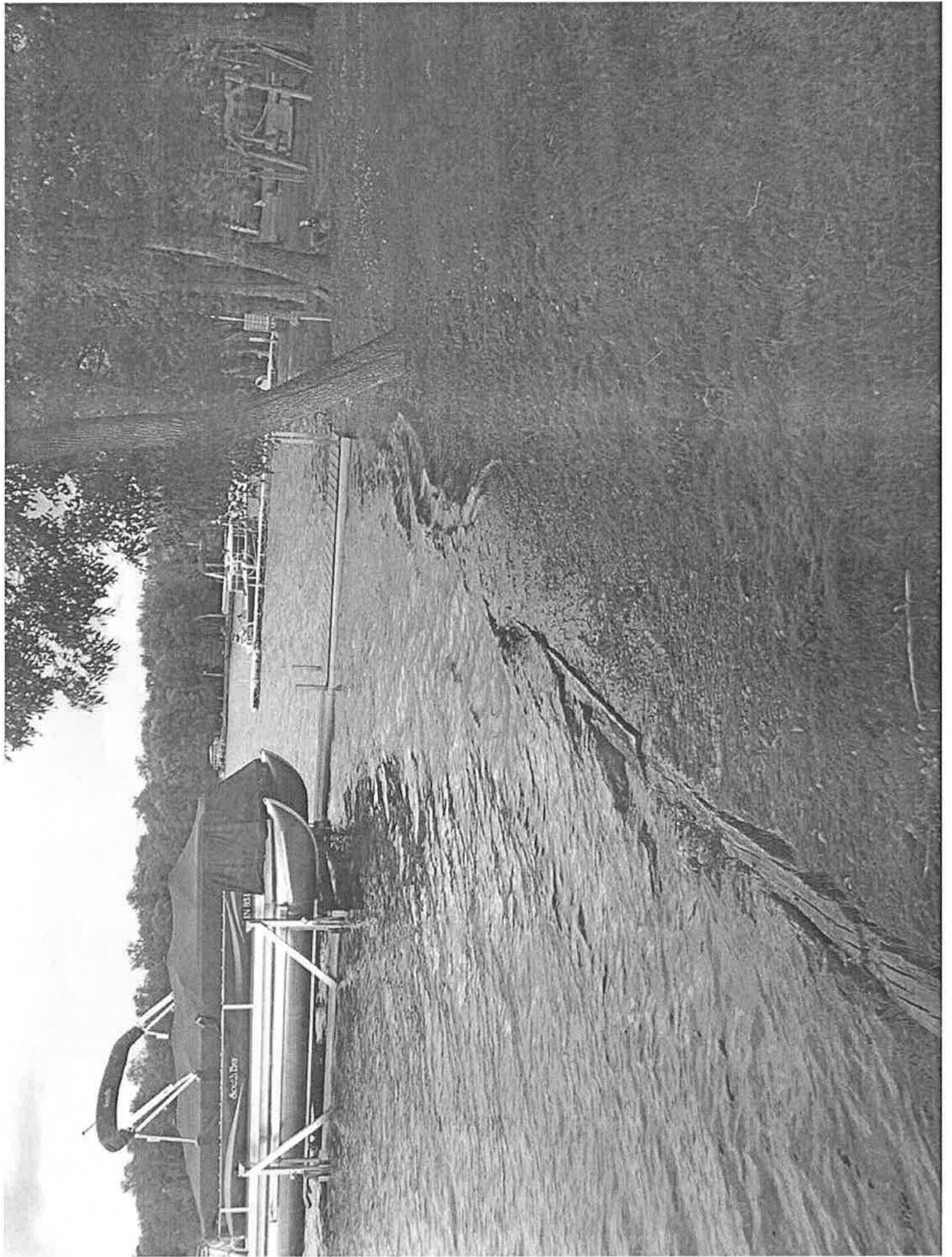

I was extremely disappointed by the Boards decision to remove the No Wake restriction on Farm Island Lake. As you can see from the pictures below, our shoreline is nearly 90% flooded with water. You can see in the 6th picture that the wake caused by boaters (not wind) have actually pushed lake debris 5-7 feet farther onto the shore. Our shoreline have railroad ties with a rock rip rap for protection. Typically, we have 1-3 feet of the rock rip rap showing and providing protection against wake from boaters and wind. You can see that due to the high water, that has disappeared. Since you originally instated the No Wake restriction, the lake level has NOT gone down, rather it has continued to rise.

What I find most troubling is that our property values continue to decrease, our taxes continue to rise, and now, at the expense of the taxpayer, our shoreline gets destroyed. It seems that the property owner gets the short end of the straw and the boaters get the long end - being allowed to cause a wake when we are in a time of extremely high water levels and continued rain. The property owners pay high taxes to live on a lake, dollars that are used to help maintain our healthy lake systems. We shouldn't be penalized by having our precious shoreline destroyed.

Please reconsider reinstating the No Wake restriction on Farm Island Lake. Boaters can still enjoy the lake by driving slowing. If they really have the need to go fast and create wakes, do it on other lakes that are as affected by the high water and continued rain.

Please feel free to contact me with any additional questions. I actually had video of boaters speeding by our dock cause significant wake, but the videos are too large to send via email.

**RE:** 2013 Budget Worksheets and Salary Calculation

**DATE:** July 6, 2012

We have attached your department's 2013 Budget worksheets (June 19<sup>nd</sup> print date) and 2013 salary projections.

After discussing the 2013 budget for several weeks, the County Board decided not to provide a specific directive related to the County Budget increasing or decreasing. They stated that they trust that the Department heads know Aitkin County has financial constraints and the Department Heads will propose budgets that meet the needs of Aitkin County. They went on to elaborate, if current staffing levels or capital purchases need to be adjusted, the Department Head should propose the necessary change with the full knowledge that the Board will make the final decision.

The Board acknowledged that they have approved negotiated contracts that have affected department budgets. They asked that we budget for a soft freeze for union employees (step increases 2013) and a 1.8% increase for S & P and other non step employees. Additionally for budgeting purposes the Board directed us to budget health insurance for Teamsters and 49ers of \$855.00 for 2013. All others on the BC/BS plan should budget for a 12% health insurance increase at this time.

Please review the salary worksheets for accuracy.

**Subject:** State Aid for Property Tax Credits and Abatements

Hello all,

After viewing some of the damage today on Big Sandy with the Sheriff's staff, I am confident that we should qualify for the minimum threshold for state aid for the disaster related property tax programs. As a result, we are putting the disaster relief fact sheet on the County Website and we will distribute them at meetings and at our counter. We will also have disaster abatement applications printed and available.

This also means that we as a staff will be doing disaster reassessments once we can access the affected properties. This will set our regular reassessment progress behind. I will get verification from the DOR that this is okay.

The amount of aid that a property owner may receive through these programs varies depending on their level of damage and their classification. Homesteads are most likely to receive aid and typically the aid amount should not be more than a few hundred dollars off one year's tax bill unless the owners do not fix their damage before January 2013.

My name is Jim Hausauer. I am currently president of the Farm Island Lake improvement Association and I would like a few minutes to address the flooding problems and specifically the "No Wake" issues on Farm Island Lake.

We have experienced considerable damage to docks, boat lifts, and the shoreline.

One of the questions being voiced by lakeshore owners is:

*Why the No Wake restriction was lifted when the water level was higher than when it was first imposed?*

There was much confusion about the "300-foot restriction." *Was there ever such a ruling?. Who are we to get our official information from?*

In order to get pertinent information to **FILIA members**, we are in the process of setting up e-mail communication to members and have already received mailing addresses for approximately 150 owners around the lake. We rely on having *correct information* to pass on to those individuals. Because the information coming from different sources was so varied, we ended up sending confusing messages. *Is there one agency which could provide accurate messages we could forward to members?*

Our communication network has been beneficial in recruiting volunteers to monitor the public accesses, to spread the word that our annual parade was cancelled, etc. It costs approximately \$ 500.00 to send out our newsletters to members, so we have attempted to reach them by e-mail. The Friday that the **(No Wake)** order was issued on all Aitkin County lakes, one of our board members walked from cabin to cabin on the south shore making certain that everyone was aware of the ruling. The DNR posted similar signs at the public accesses. Now some people are saying there was never such a restriction. The morning the No Wake restriction was lifted, on at least two of WCCO's newscasts, they were reporting that anyone planning to go to Aitkin County lakes would find No Wake rulings.

Thank you for taking time to listen to our concerns.
