AITKIN COUNTY HEALTH & HUMAN SERVICES BOARD MEETING MINUTES August 28, 2012

I. Call to Order

The Aitkin County Board of Commissioners met this 28th day of August, 2012, at 9:02 a.m. as the Aitkin County Health & Human Services Board, beginning with the Pledge of Allegiance, with the following members present: Chairperson Commissioner Mark Wedel; Commissioners Anne Marcotte, Brian Napstad, Don Niemi and Laurie Westerlund; and others present included: County Administrator Patrick Wussow; H&HS Director Tom Burke; Staff Members Sue Tange & Susan Cebelinski, Social Service Supervisors; Eileen Foss, Income Maintenance Supervisor; Cynthia Bennett, Public Health Supervisor; Kathleen Ryan, Fiscal Supervisor; Julie Lueck, Clerk to the Health & Human Services Board; Steve Bennett, IT Dept.; Ross Wagner, Economic Development Dept.; and guests; Michelle Ufford, NEMOJT, Presenter; Roberta Elvecrog, DAC & HHS Advisory; Vern Awes, HHS Advisory Committee Member; Nanci Sauerbrau, Aitkin Independent Age; and Georgia Johnson, Citizen.

III. Approval of Agenda

Motion by Commissioner Napstad, seconded by Commissioner Westerlund, and carried; the vote was to approve the agenda as presented today.

IV. Review July 24, 2012 Health & Human Service Board Minutes

Motion by Commissioner Napstad, seconded by Commissioner Marcotte, and carried; the vote was to approve the July 24, 2012 Health & Human Services Board Meeting Minutes as mailed/posted.

V. Review Bills

Motion by Commissioner Napstad, seconded by Commissioner Niemi, and carried; the vote was to approve the Bills as presented this date.

VI. General/Miscellaneous Information

- A. Economic and Workforce Program Trends Michelle Ufford, NE MN Office of Job Training gave a Powerpoint presentation on the Economic and Workforce Trends in Minnesota with comparisons to other counties in the Northeast region which included: Aitkin, Carlton, Cook, Itasca, Koochiching, Lake and St. Louis. (See copy of attached PowerPoint.)
- B. Zixport/ZixGateway Email Encryption Tom Burke discussed the secure system to communicate with encryption for e-mail. The actual cost is \$1,600 per year for 3 years or \$4,800 plus the gateway cost of \$2,457 per year for 3 years to equal \$7,371 for a three year contract. *Motion by Commissioner Napstad, seconded by Commissioner Niemi, and carried, the vote was to approve and authorize the purchase of the Zixport/ZixGateway Email Encryption service.*
- C. Budget Discussion Tom Burke/Kathy Ryan Bottom line comes in at 1.6% which brings us in just above the 2008 levy amount. Various aspects of the budget were reviewed and discussed with the Board.

- **D. PH Nuisance Abatement Tom Burke** reviewed the Public Health Nuisance property documentation for proceeding with the abatement. Motion by Commissioner Westerlund, seconded by Commissioner Marcotte, and carried, the vote was to authorize Tom Burke to proceed with the abatement of this Public Health Nuisance per Aitkin County Policy.
- E. Medica Disclosure of Ownership & Management Information & Exclusions Statement for Providers – Tom Burke discussed the issue surrounding the requested information for the Health Care Providers.

VII. Administrative Reports:

- A. Caseload Update & Graph Eileen Foss, Income Maintenance Supervisor, reviewed the monthly caseload history report.
- B. **Financial & Transportation Reports** Kathy Ryan, Fiscal Supervisor, noted that we are running on track with the budget.

VIII. Joint Powers Board Reports:

A. Tri-County Community Health Services Board (CHS) – Commissioner Westerlund / Tom Burke / Cynthia Bennett

Minutes of the August 9th meeting & Fund Balance Policy

Commissioner Westerlund discussed the MN Vaccines for Children noting this is a federally funded program to provide vaccines to underinsured or uninsured children noting that beginning July 1, 2012, private clinics will no longer be reimbursed for these vaccines, and underinsured or uninsured children must obtain this vaccine through public health if they would like the vaccine at no charge. Cynthia Bennett noted that Riverwood HealthCare Center is excluded from that although other clinics may not be. We have ordered extra vaccine from MDH in case there are families that need to access our Public Health clinics. Next meeting will be in International Falls October 10th and Commissioner Westerlund and Cynthia Bennett will be attending the CHS Conference the first week in October. Cynthia Bennett also discussed the Community Transformation Grant noting the seven county region will receive \$675,000 per year for the next four years to work on four areas to include: Health Food Environment, Tobacco Free Environment, Physical Activity Environment, and Health Care Setting Environment.

IX. Committee Reports from Commissioners

- A. H&HS Advisory Committee Commissioners Westerlund and/or Marcotte Meeting updates from Committee Members: Vernon Awes & Roberta Elvecrog Draft copy of the Minutes of the August 1st meeting. Roberta Elvecrog noted they viewed the "Just in Time" Video relating to the flood in Aitkin County and also had a presentation from Cheryl Meld, Stacey Durgin, and Kami Genz with respect to Health Education in Schools and Youth Risk Behaviors.
- B. AEOA / NEMOJT Committee Updates Commissioner Napstad noted AEOA has not met recently and NEMOJT did have a meeting and discussed the businesses that employ the people we serve and discussed their visit to a particular site, Silicon Industry, who manufacture silicon panels that they make into solar panels.
- C. CJI (Children's Justice Initiative) Commissioner Westerlund updated the Board on a presentation and update from Brian Crowley on Remnica House and its usage.

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into the 1st day of January, 2013 by and between Aitkin County Health and Human Services for the Aitkin County WIC Program, hereinafter referred to as the "Agency" and the Bethesda Lutheran Church of Malmo, hereinafter referred to as the "Bethesda Lutheran Church".

IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual promises, agreements, and understanding hereinafter set forth, it is agreed as follows:

- 1. The Bethesda Lutheran Church will provide space within their premises for the Agency to administer the Aitkin County WIC Program for eligible Women, Infants, and Children through WIC Clinics at a rate of \$15.00 per day of use.
- 2. The Agency will hold the Clinic at the contracted location once a month.
- 3. The time and dates of the WIC Clinic will be:

Every third Wednesday of the month: 9:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Any changes in rental fees, times or dates will be negotiated between the Agency and the Bethesda Lutheran Church.

- 4. The Bethesda Lutheran Church will provide tables, chairs, heat and light for the Agency to carry out the WIC Clinic. The Agency agrees to leave the premises in the same condition as at the beginning of the Clinic.
- 5. The Bethesda Lutheran Church shall take all necessary steps to maintain and keep the premises in a safe and clean condition. This shall include (a) sidewalks and parking areas cleared of snow and ice and other obstructions; (b) stairways and walkways cleared of clutter and in safe repair; (c) electrical hazards removed from the Department's area.
- 6. This agreement shall continue and be binding upon both parties until December 31st, 2013. Termination of this agreement may be made by either party with sixty (60) days written notice of intention to the other party.
- 7. The Lessor agrees to abide by all Federal and State nondiscrimination legislation to the effect that no person shall be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, age, sex, or handicap in regards to the WIC Program.

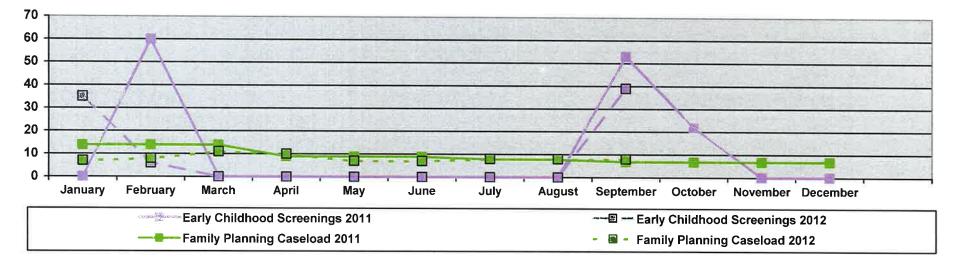
Child & Teen Checkups (C&TC) Outreach - Caseloads

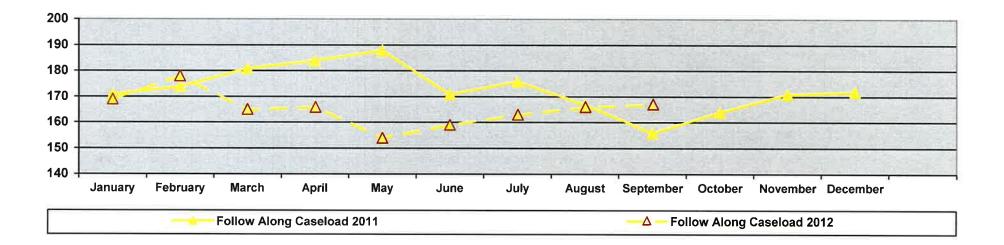

 Early Childhood Screening (ECS) / Family Planning / Follow Along

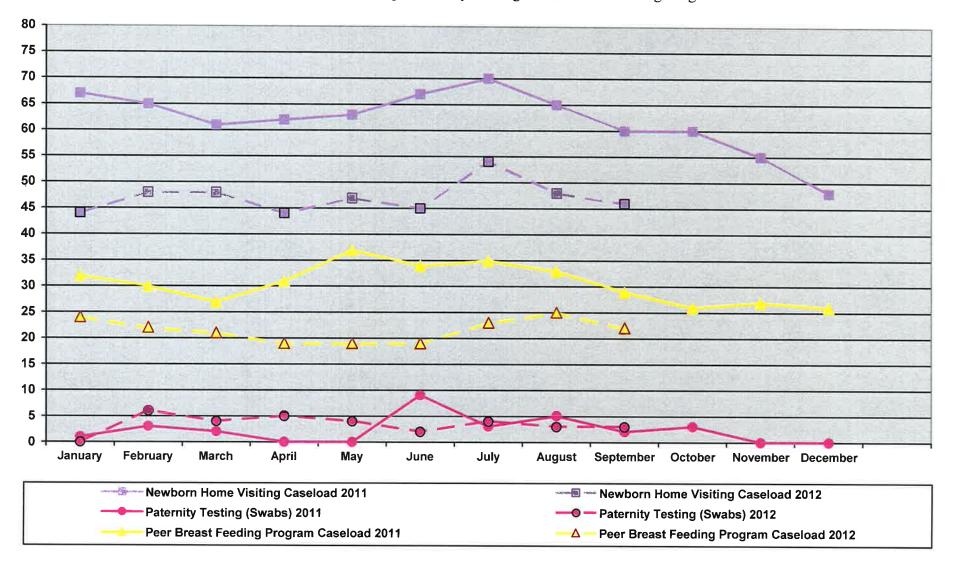

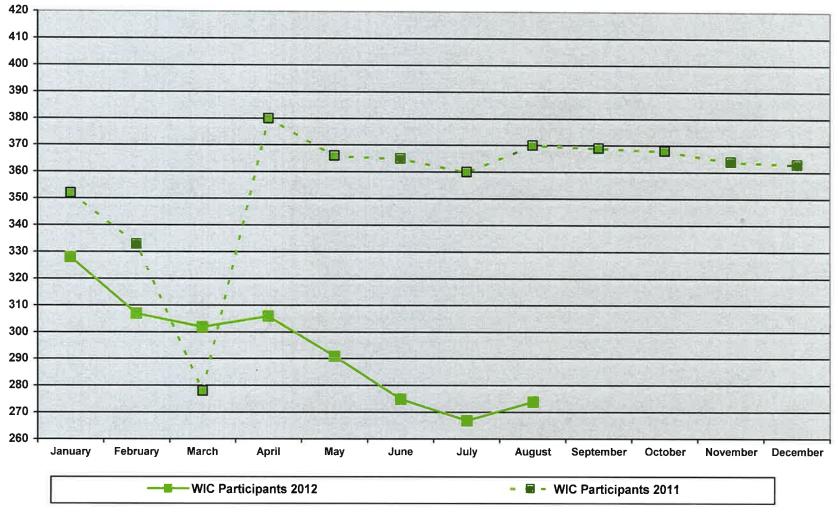

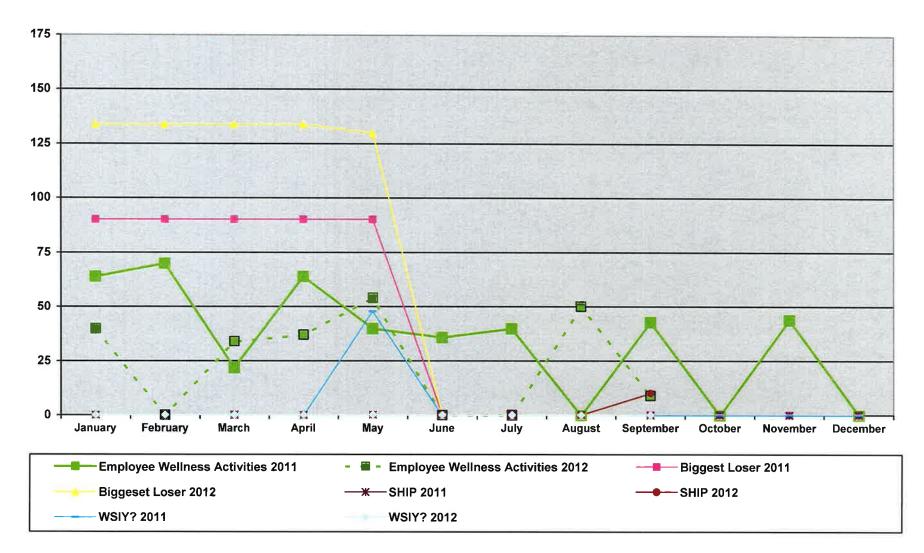

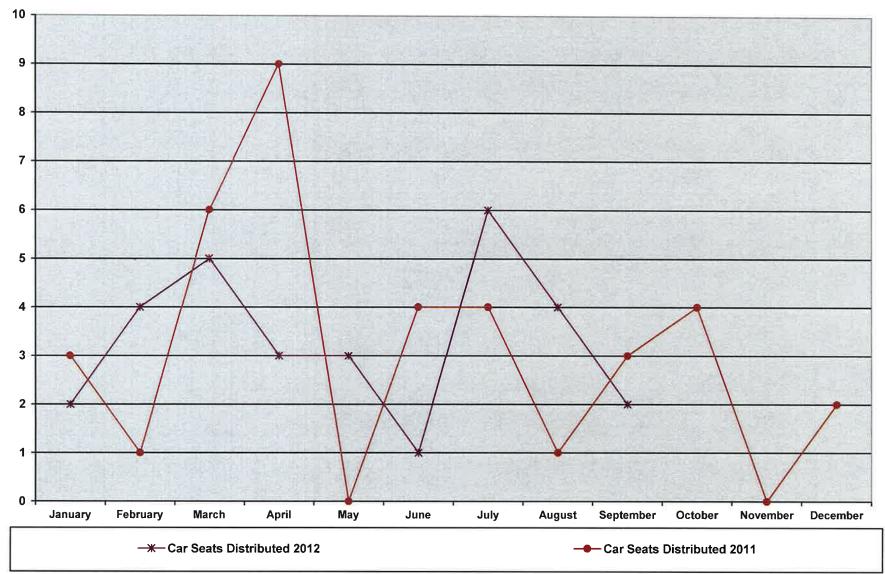

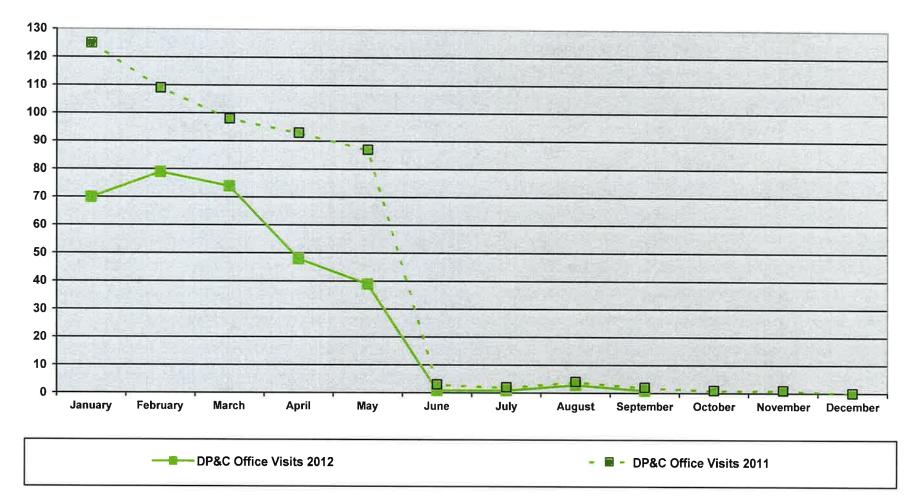

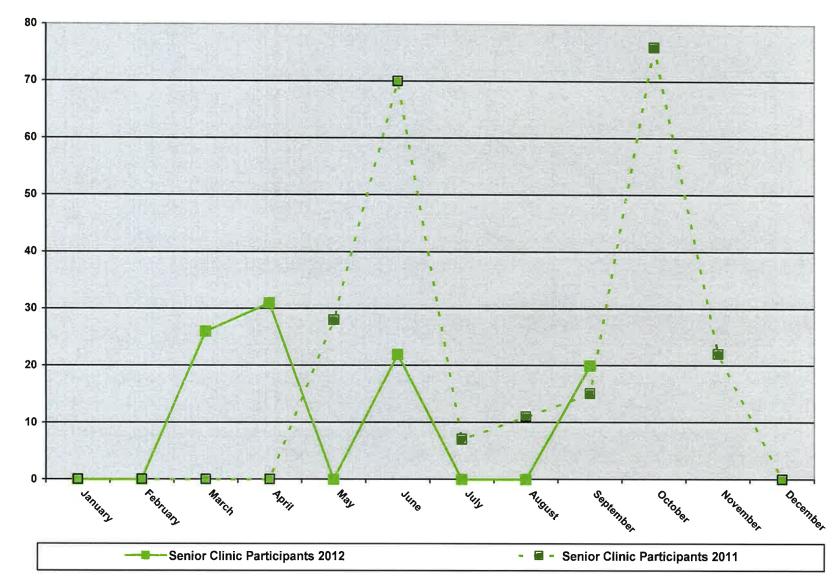

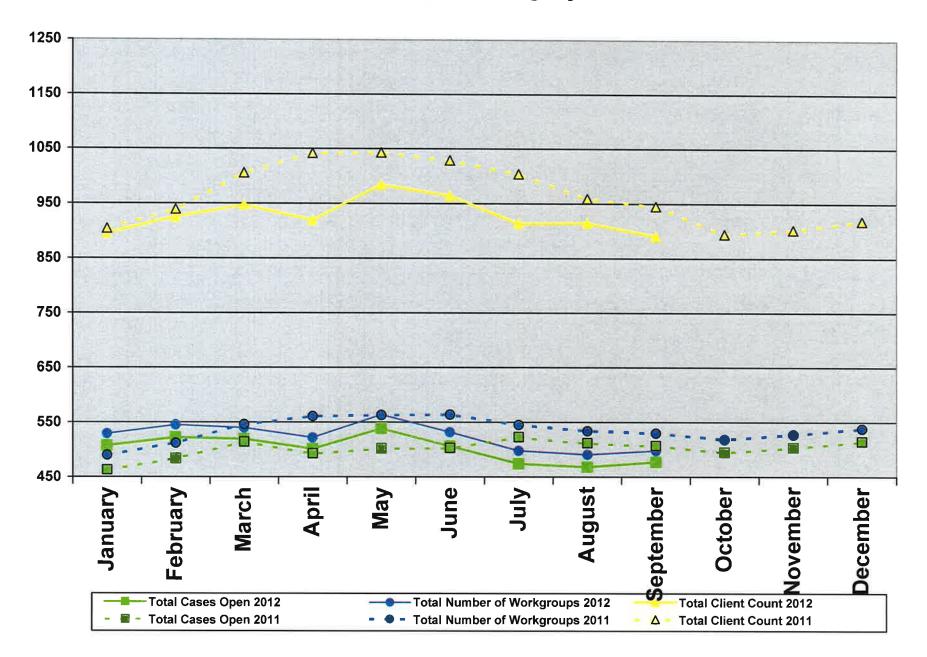

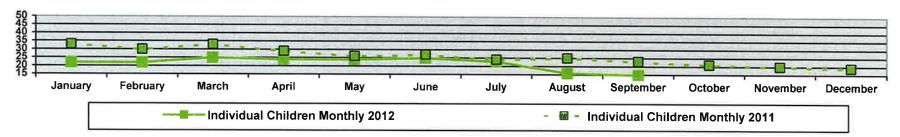

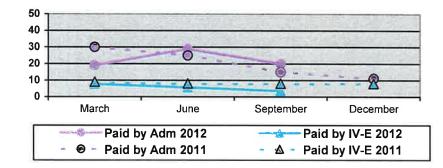
Cases Opened During the Month / Cases Closed During the Month / Closed Assessments

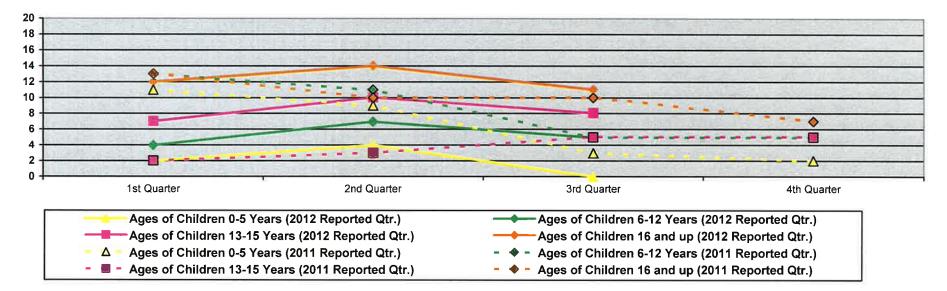
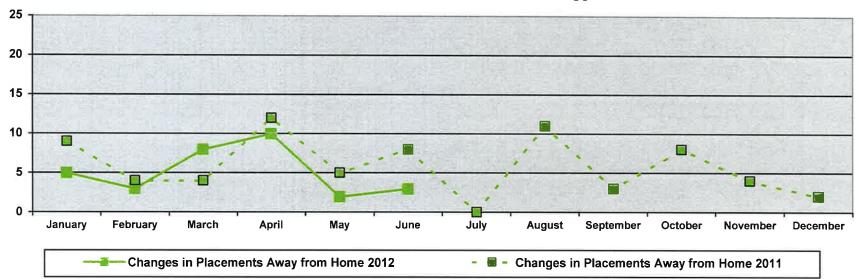
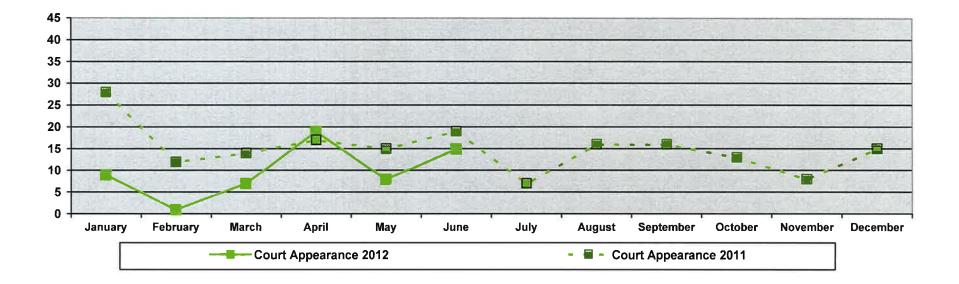


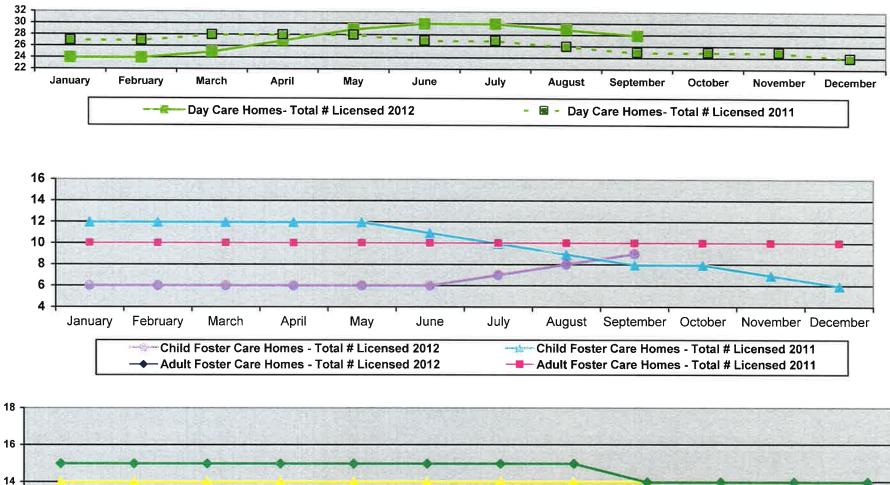
Chart 4 Changes in Placements Away from Home / Court Appearances

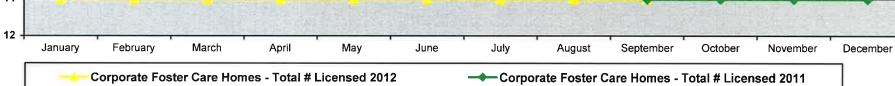


Chart 6 Maltreatment Screenings - Adult / Children
