#### Item One:

Terry Neff, Environmental Services Director, requested quotes for remodeling the Zoning Office. #### Item Two:

The 2005 Cub Cadet used for blowing snow is out of service due to a cracked and leaking rear axel casing. I have estimates for the cost of repairing the Cub Cadet, for purchasing a snow blower attachment for our existing commercial John Deere tractor, and for purchasing a used John Deere tractor from Midwest Machinery (Northwoods Equipment) to replace the Cub Cadet. 
