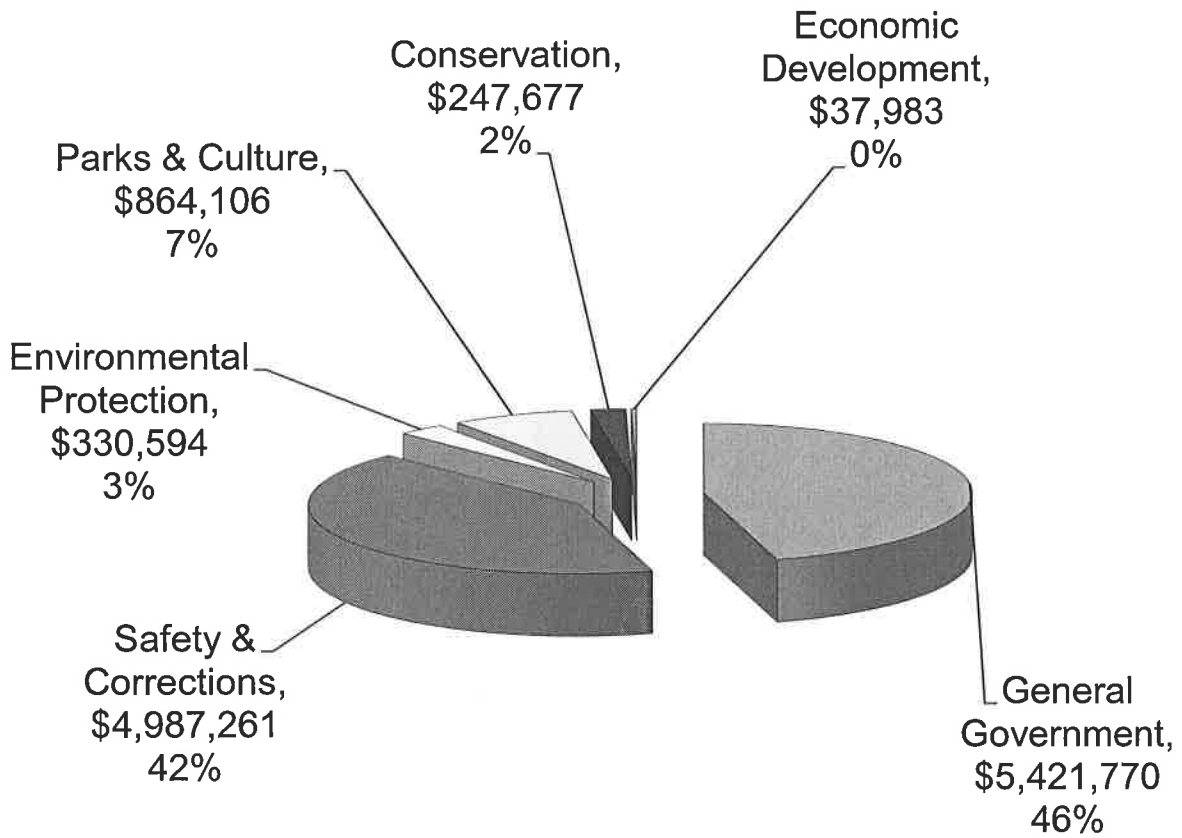

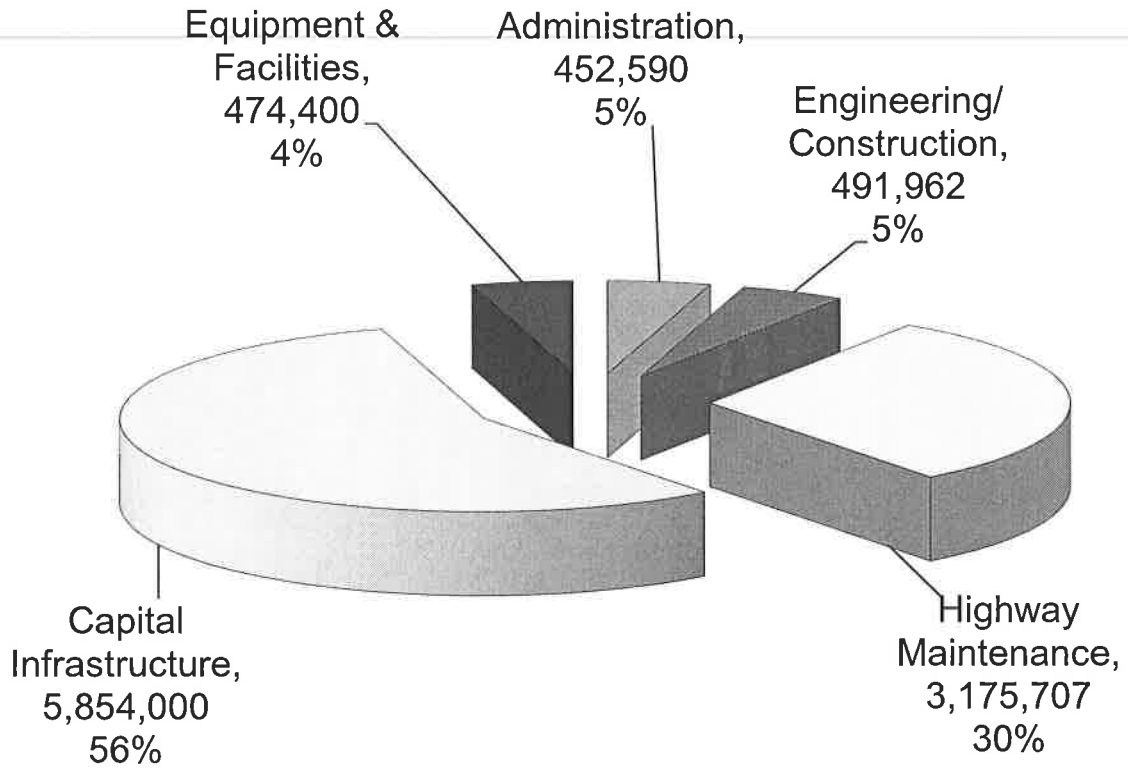

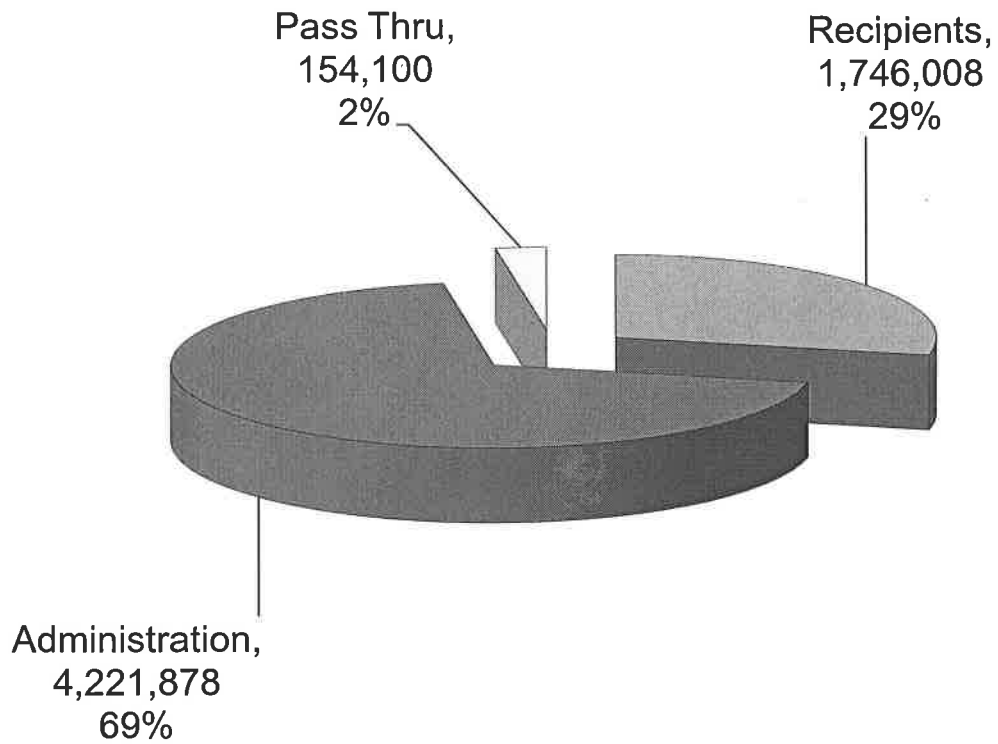
# General Revenue Fund Expenditures

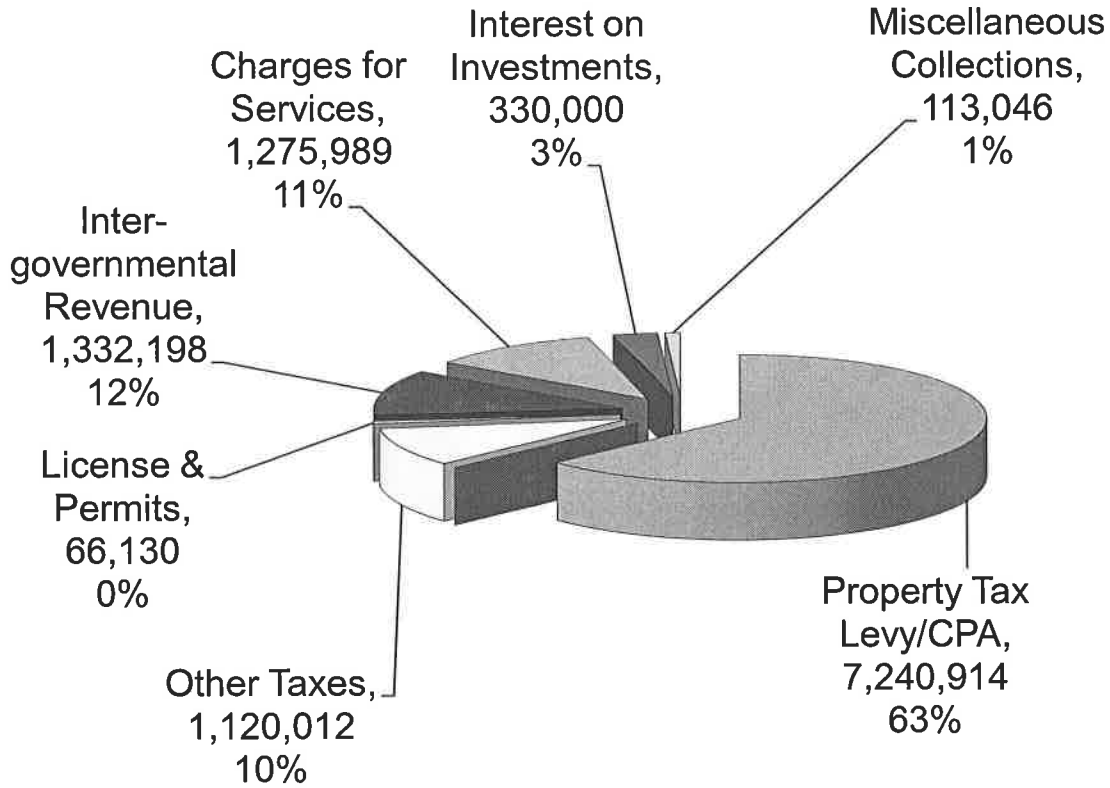

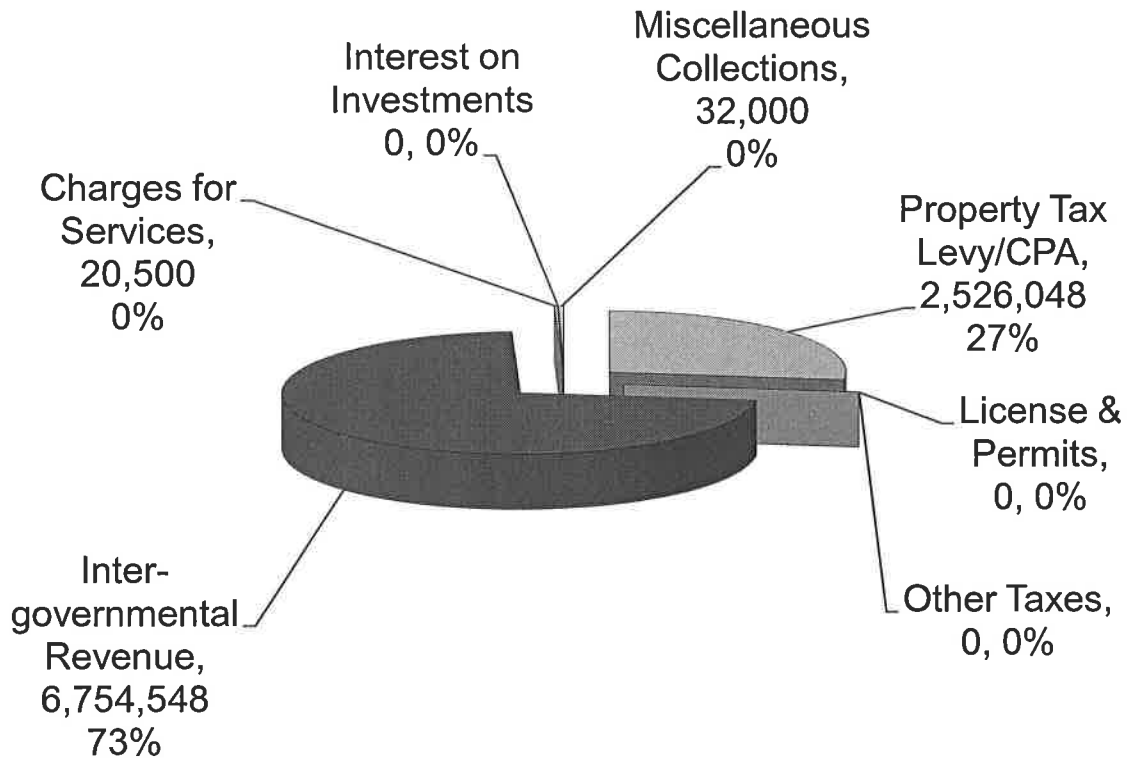

# General Revenue Fund Income Source

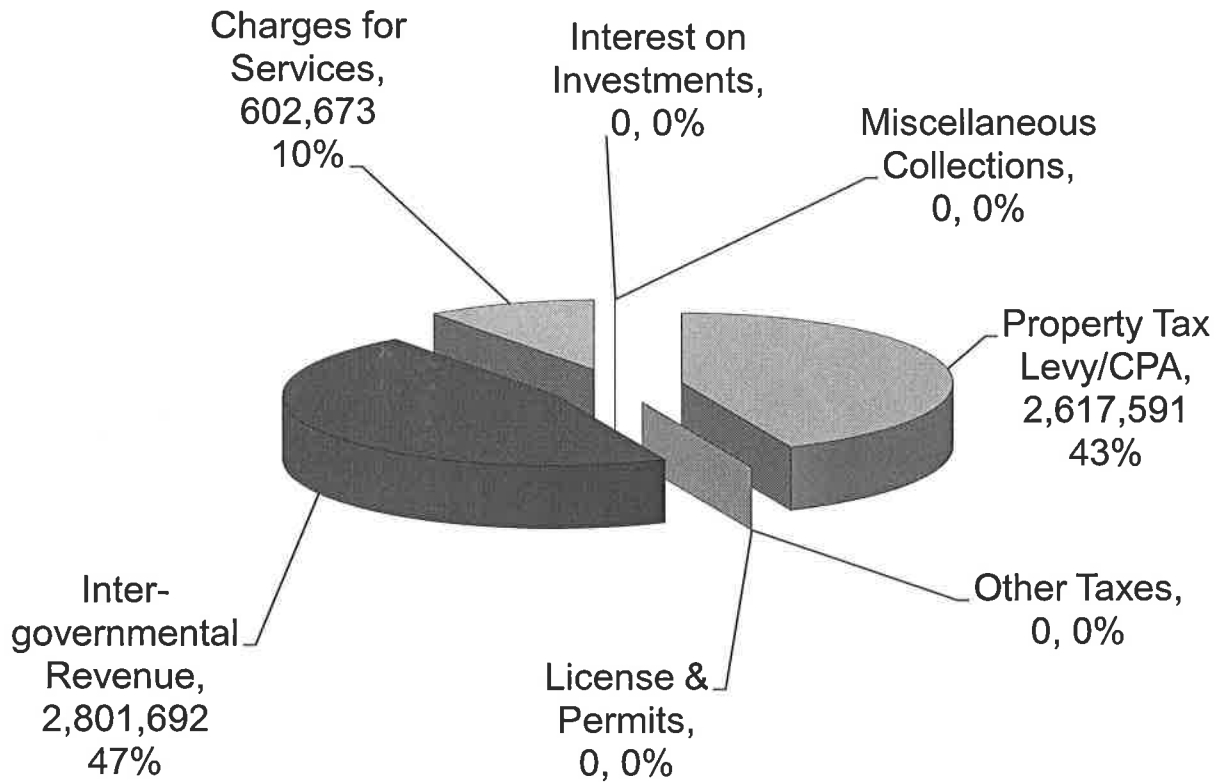




# Road & Bridge Fund Income Source

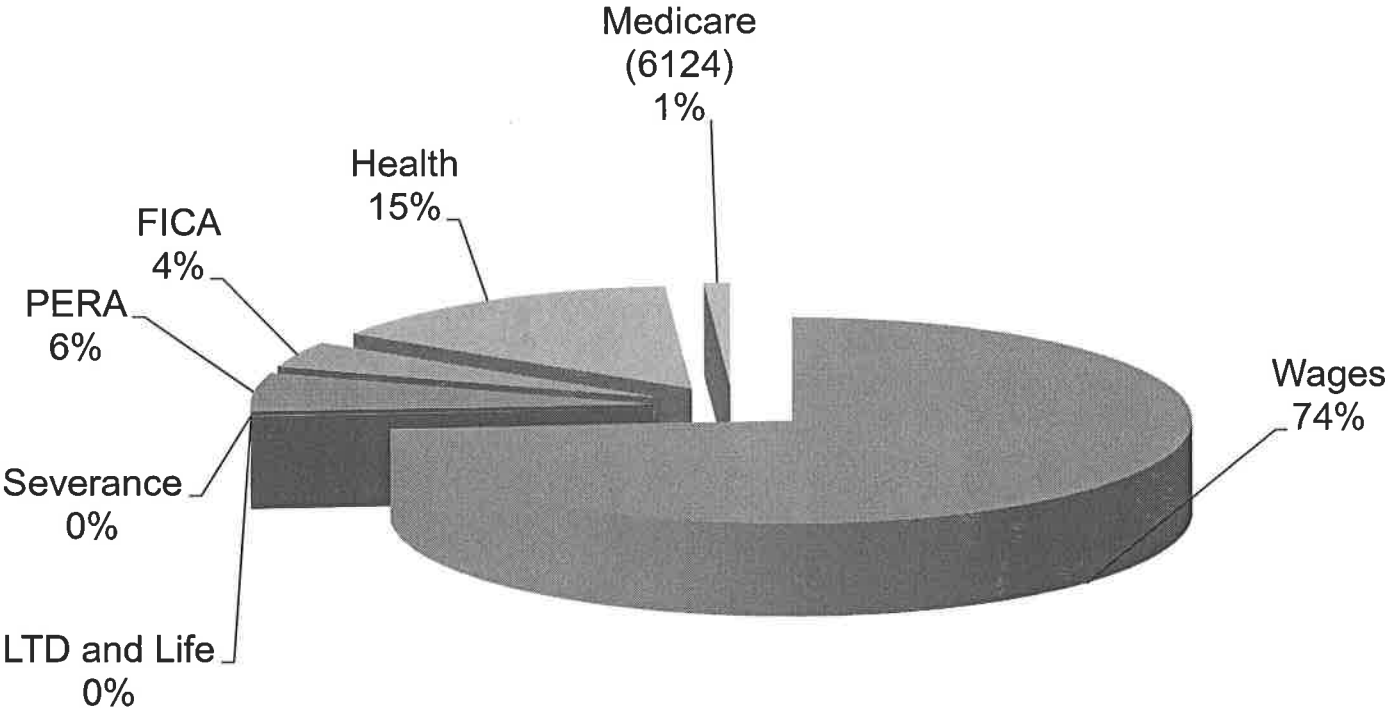

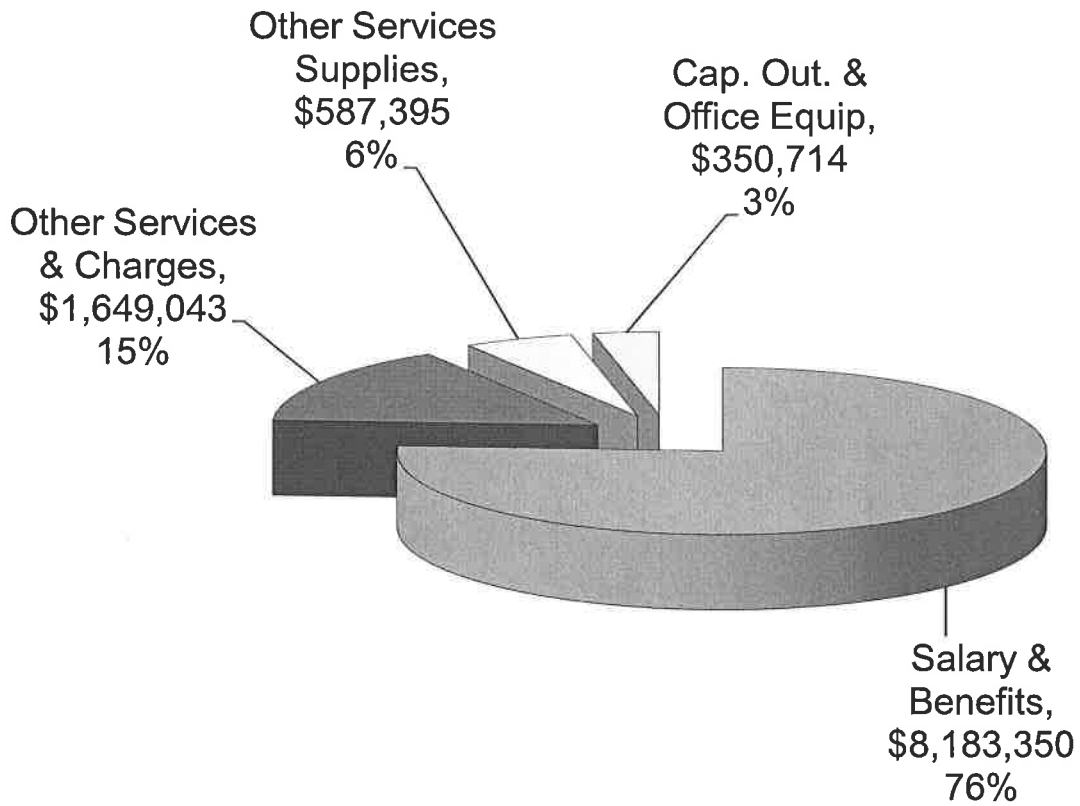

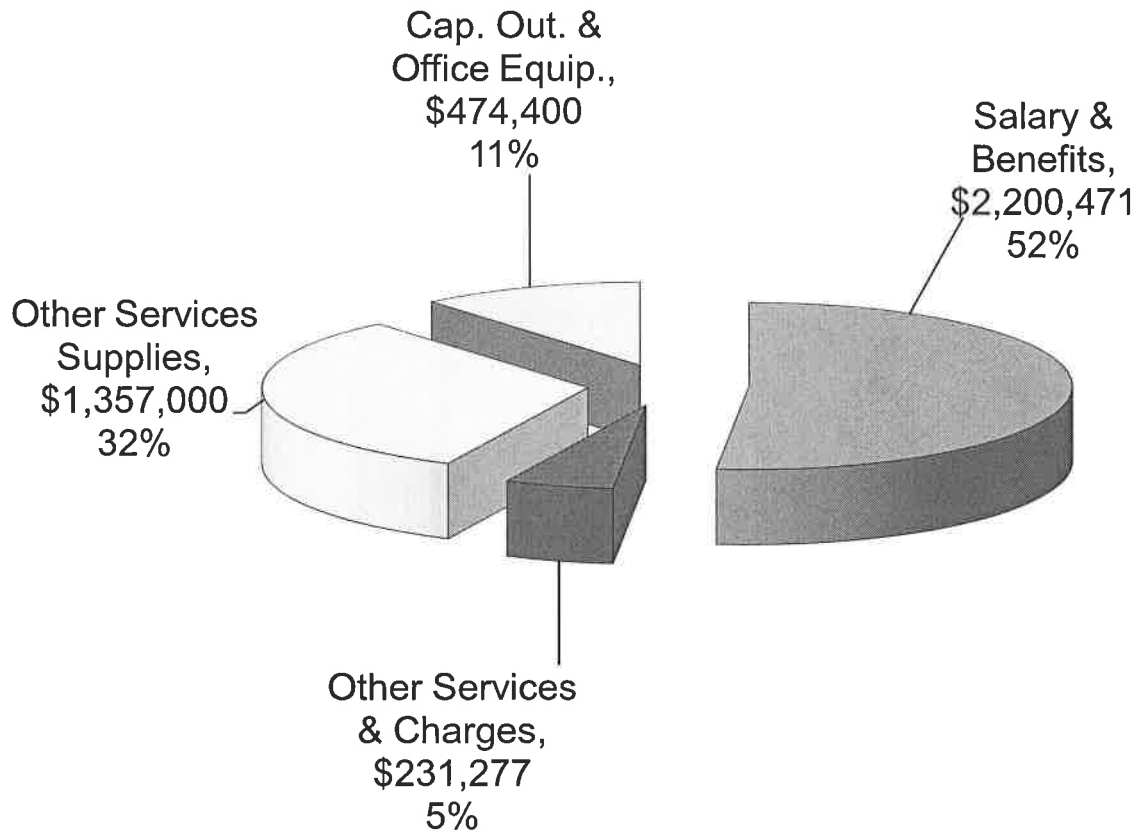
# Total Wages and Benefits



## Revenue Fund Operating Expenses

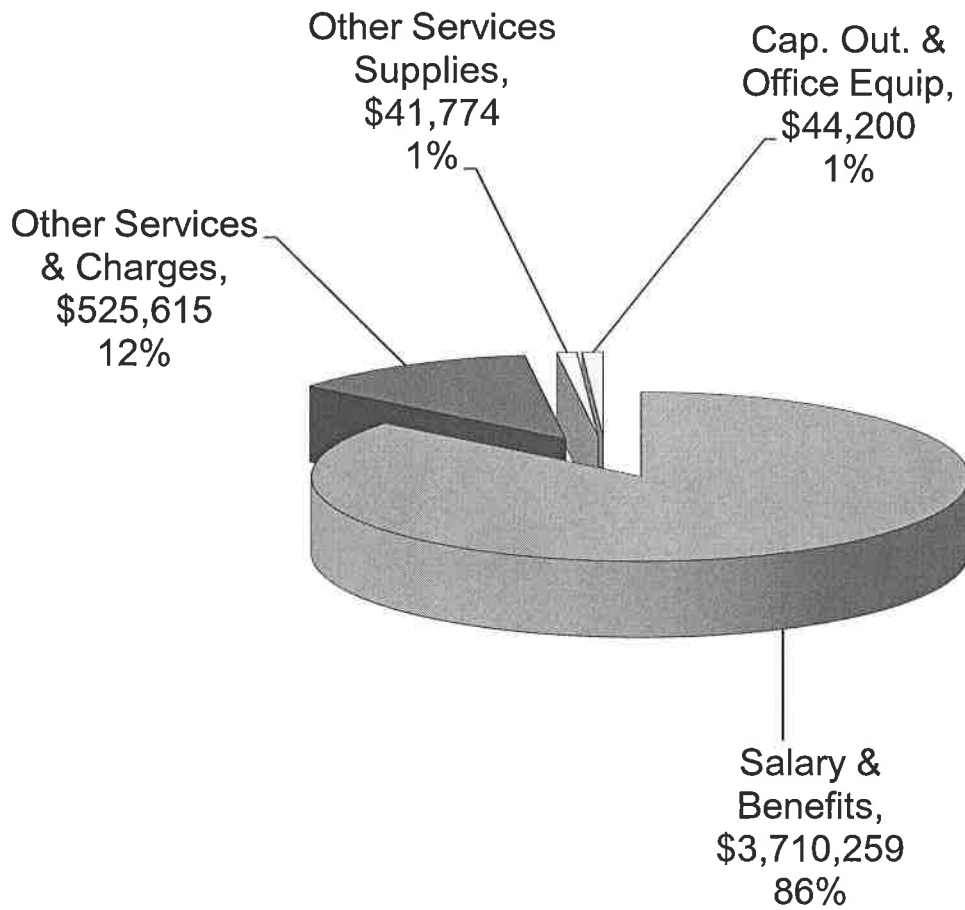


## Road & Bridge Fund Operating Expenses

The 2013 Minnesota Legislature granted an exemption from Minnesota Sales Tax to counties and cities for certain consumption and service purchases made under Minnesota Statute 297A.70 effective January 1, 2014.

Aitkin County has estimated that the budgetary savings from the sales tax exemption to be \$135,513.00.

Aitkin County's property tax levy was also frozen at the 2013 level of \$11,725,696.00, subject to the potential of 9 different levy limit exceptions which would have allowed the county board to exceed that levy limit.

The Aitkin County Board utilized the sales tax exemption savings to:

- Fund capital expenditures including equipment and road infrastructure
- Aitkin County did not raise fees and other charges for service
- Aitkin County was able to adopt a zero percent increase for its 2014 property tax levy
- Aitkin County did not have to request and quantify for levy limit exceptions
- Aitkin County was able to strengthen its budgetary position
