Dear Mr. Wedel:

I am writing to request your assistance with the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA's) upcoming Risk MAP Discovery effort, which includes your community. The Discovery process is the first step in determining whether a Risk MAP project is needed within your watershed. The information exchanged between FEMA and the communities within your watershed during Discovery will improve our understanding of your flood hazard mapping, flood risk, mitigation planning, and communication needs.

We are scheduling a Discovery Meeting for October 17th in the City of Cloquet, and on October 18th in the City of Hibbing. Please save this date on your calendar, and we will follow-up with a specific meeting location in a few weeks. At the meeting, we will review the flood risk data we have gathered to date, discuss your community's floodplains, mitigation plan and projects, flood risk concerns, and stormwater and floodplain management activities. We would like to request your help in inviting community leaders, emergency managers, GIS specialists, and local planners to the meeting (please see the enclosed brochure for a list of proposed attendees).

In preparation for the meeting, we will be hosting Information Exchange webinars. These webinars will allow us to provide an overview of Risk MAP and Discovery, and to learn about your community's unique situation. The Information Exchange webinars will be held on October 14th and October 15th, from 1pm to 2pm. You may join us at either session, but is important that you do participate so that we can be prepared to discuss your community's issues and concerns at the Discovery Meeting. In advance of the webinars, we will send you a questionnaire to fill out and return to us after the session. We will compile the questionnaire responses into a draft Discovery Report and Map, which will be used at the meeting to document all potential needs that may be addresses in a Risk MAP project.

We thank you for supporting and participating in this effort. Please look for an email from STARR, our consultant, with additional meeting details.
