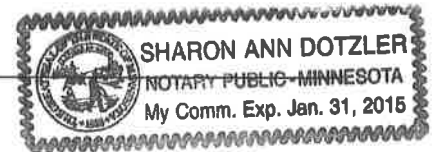

Present at the meeting were Chairperson J. Mark Wedel; Commissioners Laurie Westerlund, Brian Napstad, Anne Marcotte; County Administrator Nathan Burkett and Administrative Assistant Sue Bingham. Commissioner Don Niemi arrived at 9:08 a.m.

Motion carried, Westerlund/ Marcotte (4-0 Niemi absent), to approve the October 14, 2014, amended agenda. Item 2K – Deny Request to Repurchase Tax-Forfeited

Lands, was pulled from consent agenda and placed on regular agenda. Item 7B – Request from Historical Society for a Letter of Support, was added.
