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Summary of Issue:
Bids for annual application of 280,000 gallons of calcium chloride were opened on March 25, 2019. Two bids were received as shown on the attached abstract of bids.

Resolution:

WHEREAS, Contract No. 20191 is for the placement of calcium chloride on various county highways and township roads, and
 WHEREAS, sealed bids were opened for this project at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, March 25, 2019 with a total of two bids received, and
 WHEREAS, Knife River - Sauk Rapids, MN - was the lowest responsible bidder in the amount of \$251,720.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Knife River be awarded Contract 20191.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the chairperson of the Aitkin County Board and the Aitkin County Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract on behalf of Aitkin County with said low bidder upon presentation of proper contract documents.

Recommend award to Knife River by resolution above. Based on the results on the bid, the total cost for 400-foot dust control treatments will be \$180, with 50% of the cost (\$90) paid by the requesting landowner.

 \$196,488 was budgeted in 2019. The higher bid amount is due to a larger quantity of calcium chloride for townships than was anticipated during the 2019 budget process.


