Summary of Issue: Aitkin County timber sale contracts require that second extensions be approved by the County Board. The winter of 2019-2020 has been problematic due to unfrozen ground conditions. Despite efforts from the loggers, the following timber permits are not complete and the loggers are requesting a second extension. Permit #13657, Steve Kerr Logging and Grading Permit #13686, Futurewood Corp. As precedent, on March 15, 2019, the Aitkin County Board of Commissioners granted second extensions on timber sales due to adverse weather that required the logger to pay for the permit bond and the permit balance in full and giving the loggers two years additional years to complete harvesting. The forester/land manager and the County Land Commissioner are in favor of granting extensions with the same conditions for these sales expiring in March 2020.		
Alternatives, Options, Effects on Others/Comments: FYI, the State DNR has granted free one year extensions on all timber sales expiring in 2020. No Counties are offering this policy.		
Recommended Action/Motion: Approve the second timber sale extension requests requiring paying for the timber sale in full (no penalty).
