Presenter (Name and Title): Mike Dangers, County Assessor		Estimated Time Needed: 10 minutes
Summary of Issue: <p>The County has received 10 valid applications so far this year for property tax abatements and credits for residential fires. State Statutes provide for a disaster abatement for the year of the disaster and a credit for the year following the disaster. The last time the Board approved an abatement like this was at the September 24, 2019 meeting.</p> <p>Eight of the 10 applications are for the loss of an 8-unit condo building to fire in the Quadna development of Hill City. These were a mixture of homestead and non-homestead residences. The owners do not plan to rebuild the structure.</p> <p>The other 2 applications include seasonal structures in other areas of the County. One is owned by Tony Rogich of Farmington, MN. His mobile home burned on April 1, 2020. The second property is owned by Cory Hermann of Lakeville, MN and his seasonal structure burned on January 13, 2020.</p> <p>On page 2 is a spreadsheet detailing the loss of value due to the fires, the tax reductions due to this abatement, and other details. Page 3 has a flowchart summary of how the disaster abatement and credit works. The right-hand column pertains to our current situation. On pages 4 thru 13 are copies of each abatement application. The last pages include photos of each of the structures both before and after the fires.</p> <p>The cost of these abatements are paid by other property owners in the County as there is no State reimbursement. The Board has only approved two of these abatements in past 12 years.</p>		
Alternatives, Options, Effects on Others/Comments: <p>This type of abatement is at the Board's discretion. If the Board wishes to not approve the abatements, then the tax amounts will be reduced for the 2021 assessment and taxes payable in 2022. The Board may wish to approve some of the abatements and not others.</p>		
Recommended Action/Motion: <p>Motion to approve the disaster abatements and credits as presented. This is consistent with previous decisions the Board has made in recent years.</p>




