IN 2019, AITKIN STS CREWS AND INMATE WORKERS:

- **SAVED AITKIN COUNTY OVER \$21,000 IN JAIL COSTS**
- **WORKED ALMOST 17,000 HOURS SAVING VARIOUS ORGANIZATIONS ALMOST \$170,000 IN LABOR**
- **GAVE ALMOST 100 OFFENDERS A CHANCE TO REPAY THEIR COMMUNITY**

IN 2020, AITKIN STS CREWS AND INMATE WORKERS:


- **SAVED AITKIN COUNTY OVER \$12,000 IN JAIL COSTS**
- **WORKED OVER 10,000 HOURS SAVING VARIOUS ORGANIZATIONS OVER \$100,000 IN LABOR**
- **GAVE OVER 50 OFFENDERS A CHANCE TO REPAY THEIR COMMUNITY**

A decrease in jail population from 2019-2020 has correlated to a decrease in STS crew sizes. There have been several contributing factors to this crew size decrease, but mainly it seems alternative sentencing (treatment, sobriety court, etc.) and quarantine protocols seem to be the driving force. When we haven't had an STS crew, we have been utilizing our crew leader in many other areas of operation such as filling shifts, pipeline activities, general assistance in the jail, etc. In addition, we run our inmate worker program under the direction of STS, saving costs.


