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**Summary of Issue:**

The Land Department has a very difficult time selling some parcels of tax-forfeited land. After the auction, tracts are available over-the-counter for a period of 90 days. Parcels that have been on the auction numerous times can be purchased any time. We currently have 2 such parcels. Sale prices have been reduced and we still cannot seem to sell these particular tracts. Several other Land Departments, including Itasca and St. Louis, have utilized the services of Public Surplus to sell tax-forfeited land via an on-line auction format. We would like to explore and utilize this option for parcels that have been on the auction at least three times. On-line auctions are allowed under 282.01, Subd. 13.

Continue selling tax-forfeited parcels via in-person auctions.
