Summary of Issue:

The Aitkin County Land Department has been looking at developing a carry-in public water access on the Mississippi River in the Riverside Point area (Section 16, Twp 47, Rge 27). The land involved is county tax-forfeited land. Construction of a new carry-in public water access on the Mississippi River is of high priority under the state public water access program. After consulting with MN DNR Division of Parks and Trails Area Supervisor, it was determined that DNR would make available \$15,000 to cover the cost of the project. To receive this funding, Aitkin County would need to enter into a Cooperative Agreement with the State of Minnesota. The Agreement has been reviewed by the County Attorney.




