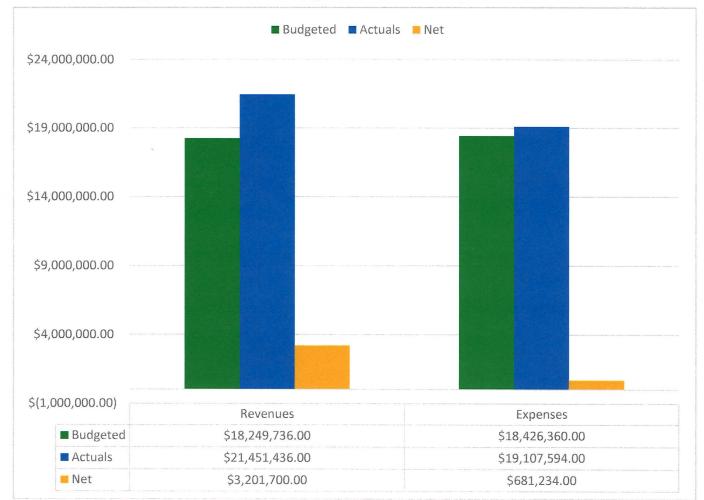

2025 Planned Use of Fund Balance –

- IT (Recorder's Fund) \$79,070
- Solid Waste \$45,000
- Capital Projects \$921,508
- In accordance with the Fund Balance Policy, a review of the Fund Balance is conducted each year after receipt of the financial statements from the outside auditor.

2024 Road and Bridge Revenue (Operations Budget Only)

- Actual Revenue \$550,736 Higher Than Budgeted
- Increased Revenue Examples:

State Aid Engineering Cost Reimbursement - \$245,710 FEMA Disaster Reimbursement - \$80,585 Wetland Bank Credits - \$89,588 Revenue from Individuals – 88,855 County Development Funds - \$131,098

• Increased revenues are often the result of the timing of reimbursements. Revenues often have direct corresponding expenses.



2024 Road and Bridge Expenses (Operations Budget Only)

Actual Expenses \$533,277 Less Than Budgeted

Decreased Expenses

Staffing/Open Positions – \$171,000 Motor Fuel, Deicing Salt, Repairs, Culverts - \$176,000 Reduced Overtime - \$59,000 (Lighter construction season & mild winter) Gravel Costs - \$125,000

(Budget every year for an expenditure that occurs every two years to level budget impacts)



Road and Bridge Fund Cash Balance

- 2023 Year End Cash Balance- \$4,058,895
 (Not adjusted for capital equipment, facilities, and projects)
- 2024 Year End Cash Balance- \$3,838,218
 (Not Adjusted for capital equipment, facilities, and projects)
- Amount Reduced From Road & Bridge Cash Balance \$220,677
- 2025 Budgeted Use of Fund Balance \$793,240
