

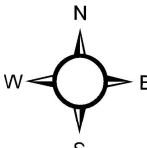
Paddle the Mighty Mississippi River in Aitkin County

Aitkin County has more Mississippi River miles than any other County in the US. The Mississippi has a steady flow with speed depending on water levels. There are no rapids to navigate or portage with an abundance of wildlife in and around the River. Ideal for beginner and experienced paddlers, if you are so inclined, don't forget fishing gear. Low water levels can make for muddy launches and landings so be prepared. Public accesses are located at the Aitkin County Campgrounds in Jacobson, Palisade and Aitkin as well as carry in and boat accesses along the river and noted on the map. River campsites are located along the river and also noted on the map.
